## LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any Temporary Local Rules displayed at the Clubhouse)

- 1. Out of Bounds:**
  - Beyond any fence and/or white stakes with black tops bounding the course. Rule 27-1 applies.
- 2. Staked Trees & Shrubs:**

If a staked tree/shrub interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball **MUST** be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b (Immovable Obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when lifted, without penalty.
- 3. Immovable Obstructions:**
  - Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green: Specimen Local Rule 5 of Appendix 1, Part B of the Rules of Golf applies.
  - All stakes defining GUR areas, Water Hazards and Lateral Water Hazards and stakes (and/or guards) supporting staked trees/shrubs, ropes, hoops and hoses are immovable obstructions. Rule 24-2 applies.
- 4. Ground Under Repair:**

The following areas are defined as Ground Under Repair:

  - Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes, white lines, GUR signage and/or accompanying rope. Relief **MAY** be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1.
- 5. Roads and Paths:**

Artificially surfaced roads and paths (including gravel) are immovable obstructions.  
Rule 24-2 applies.  
Note: All other tracks are integral parts of the course.

All fixed sprinkler heads, tap covers and grates are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 24-2. Additional relief may be taken under Specimen Local Rule 6, Appendix 1, Part B of the Rules of Golf, for immovable obstructions close to the putting green.

## THE DUNES GOLF COURSE LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with Rules of Golf 2012-2015.

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS** - all ground beyond the boundary fences. Rule 27-1b.
2. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** - Rule 24.2.
  - a. **Compulsory relief.** Relief must be taken from interference by all course maintenance equipment (hoses, sprinkler heads, signs, ropes and chains etc), staked trees, and the kin area between holes 2 and 8 on The Dunes course.
  - b. **Optional Relief.** Relief may be taken from interference by all defined paths and course markers (150m posts, 100m discs).
  - c. **Specimen Local Rule 6** (p.130 Rules of Golf 2012-2015) applies if an Immovable Obstruction is within two club-lengths of a putting green

3. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR** - optional relief. Rule 25-1. Relief may be taken from GUR areas marked with a solid or dashed white line, and the area affected by spray from an operating sprinkler.
 

Exception - compulsory relief. Relief must be taken from the Nursery area on the Dunes course 16th hole. Drop Zone provided
4. **LATERAL WATER HAZARD** - the area beyond the Dunes course 6th green. Rule 26. Drop Zone provided.
5. **MEASURING DEVICES** - players may use devices that measure or gauge distance only. Specimen Local Rule 9 p136 applies.
6. **STONES IN BUNKERS** are Movable Obstructions. Rule 24-1.
 

Penalty for breach of Local Rule: 2 strokes in Strokeplay, loss of hole in Matchplay.

**Golf Cart Rules:** Carts must be driven on fairways and cart paths only. Carts are to be kept to a minimum of 10 metres from greens, tees and bunkers unless on a path.

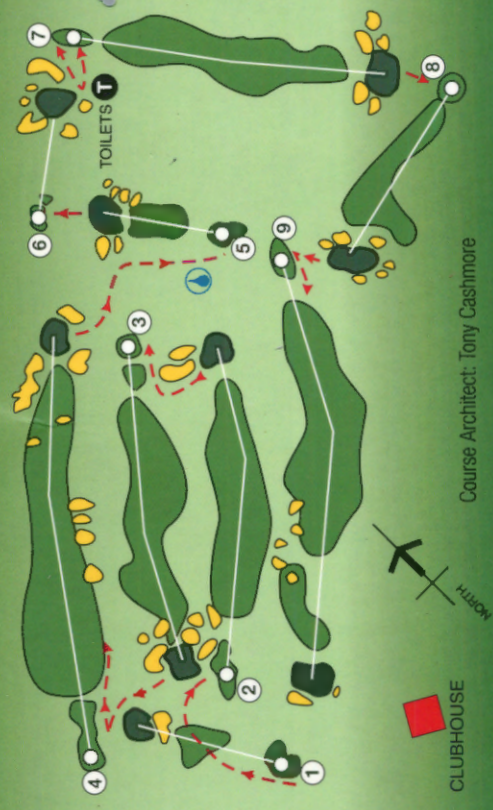

## LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any Temporary Local Rules)

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

All ground outside the Club boundaries defined by fence posts.

### 2. STAKED TREES AND SHRUBS

If a staked tree or shrub interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b. The ball may be cleaned when lifted, without penalty.

### 3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24)

(a) All stakes defining GUR areas, and stakes (and/or guards) supporting staked trees/shrubs are deemed to be immovable obstructions.

(b) Immovable Obstructions on or within two club-lengths of the Putting Green. In addition to relief available under Rule 24-2, Specimen Local Rule 6 of Appendix 1, Part B, of the Rules of Golf may provide additional relief.

### 4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25)

The following areas are defined as Ground Under Repair/Abnormal Ground Conditions:

(a) Areas defined by white stakes, white lines, and GUR signage.

(b) When a sprinkler is operating, the area directly subject to the spray is deemed to be an abnormal ground condition.

**NOTE:** Garden areas are an integral part of the course. No relief without penalty is available from them unless Local Rule No. 2 applies or an immovable obstruction causes interference (Rule 24). Woodchips on garden areas are deemed to be loose impediments.

### 5. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

### 6. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Players may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.

Stroke Play – 2 strokes

Match Play – loss of hole

**One long siren** – suspension of play **Three short sirens** – play to resume.

### 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)

The following areas are out of bounds:

- (a) Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes with black tops – eg 17th water storage
  - (b) Whilst playing the 10th hole, the area left of the line defined by white stakes with black tops
  - (c) All ground outside the boundary fence and
  - (d) Bitumen-surfaced car park area
- Players are encouraged to play a provisional ball if they believe their ball may be out of bounds.

### 2. Staked Trees and Shrubs (including guard/stakes)

If a staked tree/shrub under two club-lengths in height interferes with a player's stance or the area of the intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

### 3. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

The following items are defined as immovable obstructions:

- Grates, Sprinkler Heads & Tap Covers. Specimen Local Rule 6 of Appendix 1, Part B of the Rules of Golf also applies for immovable obstructions close to the putting green.
- All stakes defining GUR areas and stakes (and/or guards) supporting staked trees/shrubs.
- All paths/bitumen roads adjacent to the clubhouse (including the entrance road).

Note: All other course paths and roads are an integral part of the course.

### 4. Stones in Bunkers

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

### 5. Ground Under Repair (Rule 25)

- (i) Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes/lines and/or signage.
- (ii) All defined garden areas surrounding the clubhouse. Play is prohibited. Relief must be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1.

- Grates, Sprinkler Heads & Tap Covers. Specimen Local Rule 6 of Appendix 1, Part B of the Rules of Golf also applies for immovable obstructions close to the putting green.
- All stakes defining GUR areas, Water Hazards and Lateral Water Hazards and stakes (and/or guards) supporting staked trees/shrubs.  
*Note: All paths and tracks are an integral part of the course.*

**4. LATERAL WATER HAZARD (RULE 26-1) - 14<sup>TH</sup> HOLE**

As additional relief for a ball which is lost or lies in the lateral water hazard at the rear of the 14th green, under penalty of one stroke, the player may drop a ball within one club length of the nearest designated dropping stake.

**5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RULE 25)**

- (i) Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes/lines and/or signage.
- (ii) The Greens Nursery. Play is PROHIBITED. Relief must be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1.

**6. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES**

Distance measuring devices may be used. Specimen Local Rule 9 of the Rules of Golf applies.

**PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES**

Match play - loss of hole, Stroke Play - two strokes

**EXTREME WEATHER - WARNING SIRENS**

Should play be SUSPENDED due to extreme weather conditions a 15 second siren will sound. PLAYERS MUST STOP PLAY IMMEDIATELY, mark their ball and return to the Clubhouse. Rule 6-8a applies. Re-commencement of play will be indicated by two fifteen second blasts of the siren.

**PLAYING RIGHTS**

## KEYSBOROUGH GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS.** All ground outside the club's boundary fences, the car parks, residence, roundabout and roundabout rockery are out of bounds. Also, the practice fairway is out of bounds which is marked with white stakes with a black top.
2. **STAKED OR GUARDED TREES, SHRUBS AND PLANTS.** If a staked or guarded tree, shrub or plant interferes with a player's stance or intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accord with Rule 24-2-b. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
3. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS.**
  - a) Close to the putting green (sprinklers and drainage grates). Refer Rules of Golf - Appendix 1 Part B - Specimen Local Rule #6.
  - b) All stakes defining hazards, GUR, OOB and guarding trees and shrubs. Rule 24-2 applies.
4. **OVERHEAD WIRES.** If a ball strikes the overhead wires at the 17th hole, the player must replay the stroke in accord with Rule 20-5 without penalty.
5. **WATER HAZARDS.** All defined water areas, dams and drains are LATERAL water hazards. Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes or lines.
6. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR.** The following areas are defined as ground under repair.
  - a) Garden beds adjacent to the Clubhouse and the first tee. Players must take relief without penalty in accord with Rule 25-1.
  - b) These areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes, white lines, GUR signs and/or ropes. Players may take relief without penalty in accord with Rule 25-1.
7. **STONES IN BUNKERS.** Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.
8. **WHEEL MARKS.** Except in a hazard, wheel marks made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle are GUR. Rule 25 applies.
9. **DROPPING STAKES.** As additional relief for a ball which is lost or lies in the lateral water hazard at the rear of the 7th green, under penalty of one stroke the player may drop a ball within one club length of the nearest dropping stake to which the ball lay or nearest to the point at which the ball entered the hazard.

## KEYSBOROUGH GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS.** All ground outside the club's boundary fences, the car parks, residence, roundabout and roundabout rockery are out of bounds. Also, the practice fairway is out of bounds which is marked with white stakes with a black top.
2. **STAKED OR GUARDED TREES, SHRUBS AND PLANTS.** If a staked or guarded tree, shrub or plant interferes with a player's stance or intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accord with Rule 24-2-b. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
3. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS.**
  - a) Close to the putting green (sprinklers and drainage grates). Refer Rules of Golf - Appendix 1 Part B - Specimen Local Rule #6.
  - b) All stakes defining hazards, GUR, OOB and guarding trees and shrubs. Rule 24-2 applies.
4. **DVERHEAD WIRES.** If a ball strikes the overhead wires at the 17th hole, the player must replay the stroke in accord with Rule 20-5 without penalty.
5. **WATER HAZARDS.** All defined water areas, dams and drains are LATERAL water hazards. Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes or lines.
6. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR.** The following areas are defined as ground under repair.
  - a) Garden beds adjacent to the Clubhouse and the first tee. Players must take relief without penalty in accord with Rule 25-1.
  - b) These areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes, white lines, GUR signs and/or ropes. Players may take relief without penalty in accord with Rule 25-1.
7. **STONES IN BUNKERS.** Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.
8. **WHEEL MARKS.** Except in a hazard, wheel marks made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle are GUR. Rule 25 applies.
9. **DROPPING STAKES.** As additional relief for a ball which is lost or lies in the lateral water hazard at the rear of the 7th green, under penalty of one stroke the player may drop a ball within one club length of the nearest dropping stake to which the ball lay or nearest to the point at which the ball entered the hazard.

STROKE PLAY - 2 Strokes  
MATCH PLAY - Loss of hole

**Note:** Distance markers are to the CENTRE of the green.

**Storm water in use for irrigation water non potable.**

**Important:** Emergency Communication Units are located on the course on holes 6, 13 & 15 indicated by + on the card.

All players must carry and use sand to repair divots.

The low marker is responsible for the etiquette of players in the match.  
Smooth bunkers and repair ball marks.

## LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

1. **Out of Bounds:** To include the following:
  - (a) Beyond the fence bounding the course.
  - (b) The practice fairway adjacent to the 18th hole as defined by white stakes with black tops.
  - (c) The clubhouse, carparks, and driveway.
2. **Trees and Shrubs:** If a staked tree or a staked shrub interferes with a player's stance or area of his intended swing, the player **MUST** take relief as provided in Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted. The stakes (and/or guards) are immovable obstructions.
3. **Water Hazards:** Water Hazards are defined by yellow stakes and Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red stakes. The stakes are immovable obstructions.
4. **Putting Greens 8th and 16th Holes:**

The putting greens at the 8th and 16th holes are to be treated as a single green unless the player whose ball lies beyond its neck elects to use a club other than a putter in which case Rule 25-3 (ball on wrong putting green) shall apply.
5. **Stones in Bunkers:**

"Stones in bunkers are declared as movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)."
6. **Fixed Sprinkler Heads and Tap Covers:**

Fixed sprinkler heads and tap covers are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under rule 24-2. In addition specimen Local Rule 6 Appendix 1 rules of golf also applies.
7. **Distance Measuring Devices:**

"Specimen Local Rule 9, Appendix 1 Rules of Golf also applies."
8. **Paths and Tracks:**

All paths and tracks are deemed to be an integral part of the course.
