

THE ROSANNA GOLF CLUB – LOCAL RULES EFFECTIVE 1/7/2019
(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any temporary local rules.)

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

All ground beyond the line of the inside edge at ground level of the out of bounds posts (black topped, white posts) or the club's boundary fences (excluding angled supports) is out of bounds.

2. DROPPING ZONES AT THE 2nd, 3rd, 8th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 14th and 18th HOLES

If the ball crosses the margin of the penalty area between the green topped red stakes on the holes mentioned above, the player, under the penalty of one stroke, as an additional option, may drop the ball in the nearest dropping zone, even if this is nearer the hole.

When the player is using the dropping zone, the ball must be dropped within club length no nearer the hole. The ball may roll a further club length, but must finish no closer to the hole than the stake.

3. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS

No Play Zones – PLAY PROHIBITED, relief MUST be taken

- Garden beds adjacent to 1st, 4th and 10th tees. The edge of the zone is defined by stone or wooden retaining walls.

- Staked trees. The No Play Zone is the area which interferes with the ball, the player's stance or the area of the intended swing.

Ground Under Repair – tree relief may be taken

- Damage to bunkers caused by animals.

- For a ball lying in or touching a wheel rut in the general area. But interference does not exist for the player's stance.

Immovable Obstructions – relief may be taken

- Wooden steps leading into bunkers. These are deemed to be outside the bunker so, if the ball lies on the steps, relief may be taken outside the bunker.

- In addition, the player may take relief if the ball is in the General Area and an immovable obstruction is on the line of play. The immovable obstruction must be within 2 club-lengths of the putting green and within 2 club-lengths of the ball. There is no relief if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

Movable Obstructions which are deemed to be Immovable Obstructions

- Stakes defining Penalty Areas.

- Stakes and guards around trees and shrubs.

- Operating hoses.

- Drop zone markers are immovable obstructions.

Players should refer to The Rules of Golf for further information, guidance in taking relief and for dropping procedures.

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for a breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty.

LOCAL RULES Read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any Temporary Rules

1 OUT OF BOUNDS: (Rule 18.2). Beyond any *boundary object*, all permanently sealed car parks, and the maintenance complex. *Internal O.O.B* marked by white stakes with black tops are located adjacent to the Bowling Green & Tennis Court area, and on the 17th North where any ball finishing to the left of these stakes is O.O.B.

2 PENALTY AREAS: (Rule 17). These are defined as red or yellow *penalty areas* by stakes, pavers, or lines of the corresponding colour. Relief options are listed under Rule 17.1d. When the ball last crossed the edge of a red *penalty area* on holes 2S, 3S, 5S, and 10S, on penalty of one stroke, the player may also drop a ball on the opposite edge of the *penalty area*, with both reference points the same distance from the hole.

(a) Playing Ball Provisionally Under Model Local Rule B-3

If there is doubt whether a ball is in the red *penalty area* on hole 13S, the player may play a *provisional ball* under Rule 18.3, using all options of Rule 17.1d. If the original ball is found outside the *penalty area* it must be played, or if inside the *penalty area* it may be played as it lies, but otherwise, the provisional ball becomes the ball in play.

3 ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: (See Rule 16 for Definition and Relief Options)

(1) IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Free relief under Rule 16.1)

(a) Include all artificially surfaced roadways, paths, boardwalks, and the pavers, stakes, rails and associated ropes defining *penalty areas*, *internal O.O.B*, *G.U.R.* and *no play zones*. Path matting, wooden control barriers, course furniture, and all drinking fountains are also *immovable obstructions*. All stone walls and other stone works, are *integral objects* and not *obstructions*.

(b) Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green - Line of Play Interference. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists for a ball in the *general area* if

an *immovable obstruction* on or within two club lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball, is on the player's reasonable *line of play*. Relief is available under Rule 16.1b.

(2) GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Defined as any area of the course bounded by white lines or white stakes.

(3) NO PLAY ZONES (NPZ): Free relief must be taken from interference by these *no play zones*, deemed abnormal course conditions, under Rule 16.1f.

(a) Trees and Shrubs. Trees and shrubs that are staked, guarded, or otherwise marked are *no play zones* which include the stake and any wrapping. For a ball in a *penalty area*, relief must be taken under Rule 17.1e.

(b) The Clubhouse Buildings & Environs. The Clubhouse buildings, their associated structures, paving and formal garden beds. The reference point for free relief under Rule 16.1b must be on the green side of the NPZ, and in the *general area* of the hole being played.

(c) The Remote Accommodation. The NPZ is defined by the green tipped white stakes.

(4) SANDY WASTES: The sandy areas located throughout the golf course that do not have rakes in or adjacent to them are part of the *general area*, and are not *bunkers*. No relief for *embedded ball*.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

Stroke Play – Two strokes. Match Play – Loss of hole. Unless otherwise noted Distances on sprinkler heads are in metres to the Front, Centre, and Back of the green.

Buggies, Carts or similar equipment are not permitted on the Greens.

Siren: Play is to be suspended immediately when the Siren is sounded. (Rule 5.7b). All players must return to the Clubhouse.

LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any temporary local rules.

1. Out of Bounds - (Rule 18.2)

Beyond the course side edge of any fence or road bounding the course, Areas defined by white stakes.

2. Abnormal Course Conditions - (Rule 16.1)

Ground under repair

All areas defined by broken white lines are abnormal course conditions. Free relief may be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 16.1b

3. Immovable Obstructions

All boundary objects (e.g. stakes) defining Penalty Areas are immovable obstructions.

Cart Paths and Internal Roads

NOTE: all other paths and tracks are an integral part of the course.

4. Young Trees and Shrubs - (Rule 16.1f)

Young trees and shrubs identified by stakes and/or protected by a tree guard are **NO PLAY ZONES**. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree/shrub or such a tree/shrub interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.

5. Immovable Obstructions (eg. Sprinkler Heads) Close to Putting Greens - Line of Play Interference - (Rule 16.1b)

Rule 16.1b applies to immovable obstructions close to putting greens. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, and is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. (Exception - there is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable)

6. Red Penalty Area Dropping Zone (4th Hole Old Course)

As additional relief to options available under Rule 17.1d, for a ball which is lost or lies in the penalty area at the front of the 4th green of the Old Course, under penalty of one stroke, the player may drop a ball within the Drop Zone. The Drop Zone is situated within one club length of either of the Drop Zone markers.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for a breach of a Local Rule is the General Penalty.

(Match Play - Loss of hole, Stroke Play - Two Strokes)

Measurements shown on top of sprinklers are in metres to the centre of the green.

LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any temporary local rules.)

1. Course Boundaries and Out of Bounds (Rule 2.1)

The following areas, defined by white stakes with black tops, are out of bounds (OOB). All OOB stakes and boundary fence posts are out of bounds.

- Right of the 1st Hole beyond the OOB stakes;
- Whilst playing the 10th hole, the area on the left beyond the OOB stakes;
- Right of the 17th hole beyond the OOB stakes – water storage area;
- Bitumen-surfaced car park area and garden beds therein;
- All ground beyond boundary fence posts

Note: The OOB edge is defined by the line between the course-side points of the fence posts/stakes at ground level.

Players are encouraged to play a provisional ball if they believe their ball may be out of bounds.

2. Abnormal course conditions - Including Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16.1)

May take relief:

- Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes/lines and/or signage.

Must take relief:

- 'No Play Zone' (Abnormal course condition), those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes/lines and signage.
- Staked trees, staked shrubs under two club-lengths in height, including stakes and/or guard supports.
- All defined garden areas and paths surrounding the clubhouse.

Note: Certain GUR areas have dropping stakes as an additional relief option. When applicable, free relief may be taken at the nearest dropping stake which may be nearer the hole.

All other course paths and roads are integral objects – no free relief available.

3. Immovable obstructions (Sprinkler heads) close to putting green LINE OF PLAY INTERFERENCE

Rule 16.1b applies to immovable obstructions close to putting greens. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, and is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for a breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty (stroke play – two strokes, match play – loss of hole). Please leave rakes outside bunker – one metre from the edge parallel to the hole. Measurements shown on sprinklers are in metres to the centre of the green.

LOCAL RULES

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS** - The practice fairway and car park are deemed to be out of bounds. The black chain wire fence on the northern side of the 18W fairway and the white post along the line of the Cypress trees determine the boundary. Ground outside the Club boundary fences is out of bounds.
2. **SPRINKLER HEADS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS - LINE OF PLAY INTERFERENCE**
Sprinkler heads and tap covers are immovable obstructions. Rule 16.1b applies to sprinkler heads and tap covers where the obstruction is on the player's line of play, and is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. (Exception - There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)
3. **STAKED TREES** - Staked trees and shrubs are no play zones and are ground under repair (the GUR includes the stake and any wrapping). The ball must be lifted, without penalty and relief is allowed under Abnormal Course Conditions Rule 16.1.

DISTANCE MARKERS - Distances on sprinkler heads are to the centre of the green.

EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION - Emergency communication units are located on all automatic gates. Locations: Cheltenham Road, Reserve Road, Moray Road and Weatherall Road.

LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any temporary local rules.

Metropolitan endorsed Ready Golf as a standard format in 2017. Endorsed by the R&A and promoted by Golf Australia, Ready golf guidelines are available, and all players are encouraged to use this format to combat slow play.

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)

Beyond any fence bounding the course.

2. STAKED TREES AND SHRUBS (Including Guard/Stakes)

Staked trees and staked shrubs are No Play Zones and are Ground Under Repair (the GUR includes the stake and any wrapping).

3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16)

The following items are defined as Immovable Obstructions:

- **Sprinkler heads close to putting greens – line of play interference.** Rule 16.1b applies to Immovable Obstructions close to putting greens. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists if an Immovable Obstruction is: on the player's line of play, and is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the

Measurements shown on sprinklers are in metres to the CENTRE of the green.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for a breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty (stroke play – two strokes, match play – loss of hole).

PLAYING RIGHTS

Players on the timesheet (providing they tee off on time) have right of way on the starting tee over players who are coming

- All stakes defining GUR areas, Red Penalty Areas and stakes (and/or guards) supporting trees/shrubs)

Note: All paths and tracks are an integral part of the course.

4. RED PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

As additional relief for a ball which is lost or lies in the Red Penalty Area at the rear of the 14th green, under penalty of one stroke, the player may drop a ball within one club length of the nearest designated dropping stake. (When the player is using a dropping zone, the ball must be dropped in the dropping zone and it must come to rest in the dropping zone.)

5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1)

The Greens Nursery is a No Play Zone that is to be treated as Ground Under Repair. Free relief must be taken from interference by the No Play Zone under Rule 16.1f.

LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with Rules of Golf and the Rules of the Day.

- 1. Out of Bounds:** All grounds beyond the fences and those areas left of the water in the creek at the 6th and 7th holes.
- 2. Embedded ball:** A ball embedded in any closely mown area (fairway length) may be lifted and dropped without penalty, not nearer the hole.
- 3. Lateral Water Hazard:** The creek, its banks and other areas defined by red stakes.
- 4. Fixed sprinkler heads:** All sprinkler heads and other watering equipment are to be treated as immovable objects.
- 5. Wheel Marks:** If a wheel track of any course equipment substantially interferes with a players stance or the area of intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted or dropped not nearer the hole.
- 6. Staked Trees:** When a staked tree or a tree, under two club lengths in height, interferes with a players stance or the area of intended swing, the ball may be lifted and dropped without penalty.
- 7. Course Play:** A ball coming to rest on any green other than that of the hole being played MUST be lifted and dropped off that green not nearer the hole, and at the nearest point of relief.

NB. A ball lifted under these local rules may be cleaned.

You are responsible for any damage or injury caused by you or the golf ball.

LOCAL RULES

TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH
THE RULES OF GOLF

Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2):

Is defined by –

- The fence bounding the course.
- White stakes with Black tops – practice fairway adjacent to the 18th fairway.
- The clubhouse (including paved areas) & carparks.

Alternative to Stroke & Distance:

When a player's ball has not been found, or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds the player may proceed under the Stroke and Distance Local Rule for a **penalty of two strokes**, rather than proceeding under stroke and distance. This Local Rule is not available if a provisional ball has been played.

Shared Green 8th & 16th:

The green serving holes **8 & 16** is considered to be two separate greens divided by **the neck of the green**.

A player who elects to use any club other than a putter, and has interference with the portion of the green for the hole not being played, is on a wrong green and must take relief under Rule 13.1f.

Red Penalty Areas (Rule 17):

Red penalty areas are defined by red stakes. These stakes, unless the ball rests in the penalty area, are to be treated as immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Protection of Young (Staked) Trees:

Young trees identified with a supporting stake are no play zones:

- If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course, other than in a penalty area, and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.
- The stakes (and / or) tree guards are immovable obstructions.

Fixed Sprinkler Heads and Tap Covers:

All fixed sprinkler heads and tap covers are immovable obstructions. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

Suspension and Resumption of Play:

An immediate suspension of play will be signalled by a **continuous siren of 15 seconds**. All other suspensions will be signalled by **four sirens blasts**. In either case, resumption of play will be signalled by **two siren blasts**. See Rule 5.7b.

Paths & Tracks:

All paths and tracks are deemed to be an integral object.

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the General Penalty.

- 3. STAKED TREES** - Staked trees and shrubs are no play zones and are ground under repair (the GUR includes the stake and any wrapping). The ball must be lifted, without penalty and relief is allowed under Abnormal Course Conditions Rule 16.1.

DISTANCE MARKERS - Distances on sprinkler heads are to the centre of the green.

STANDING LOCAL RULES

Please utilise in conjunction with the Club Mandalay Official Scorecard

Out of Bounds

1. Beyond any white line or white stake with a black top defining the boundary of the course, or beyond any wall or fence defining the boundary of the Club's property. Objects defining Out of Bounds are deemed to be fixed.
2. On the 9th and 18th greens, beyond the concrete cart path surrounding the Club House and practice areas.
3. On the 1st, 2nd, 4th and 18th holes the gravel cart path to the far left of the holes is classed as the boundary. Any ball finishing beyond this gravel path will be deemed Out of Bounds.

Penalty Area

Are defined by a boundary of Red Stakes with any ball lying within the boundary of Red Stakes deemed to be in the Penalty Area.

Ground Under Repair

Any area defined by White Stakes and/or a broken white line. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Staked Trees

Staked Trees and Staked Shrubs are Immovable Obstructions. The Immovable Obstruction includes the tree/shrub, and the stakes, and any artificial or protective guard. If the Immovable Obstruction interferes with the player's stance or the area of their intended swing, the ball may be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 16.1.

Roads and Paths

Are classed as Immovable Obstruction and relief is available under Rule 16.1.

Stones in Bunkers

1. Stones in bunkers are classed as Movable Obstructions and Rule 15.2 applies.
2. Immovable Obstructions in a Bunker where the underlay of a bunker is protruding through the sand, it is treated as an Immovable Obstruction. If any part of this underlay interferes with a player's stance, swing or lie, relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Internal Fences

Relief is available from the internal fences on holes 12, 13 and 14 under Rule 16.1 - Immovable Obstruction.

Cracks

Relief is available from all cracks in the General Area under Rule 16.1.

LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

1. **Fixed sprinkler heads, stakes and hoops:** All fixed sprinkler heads, stakes, hoops, hoses, and course signage are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained without penalty under rule 16.1.
2. **Immovable obstructions near the green:** If a player's ball is within two club lengths of the green and an immovable obstruction interferes with their line or stroke, they may take relief no nearer the hole without penalty under rule 16.1a and 16.1d.
3. **Animal scratchings and prints:** Relief may be taken from paw prints and scratchings made by kangaroos and other animals on greens and in bunkers without penalty under rule 16.1c-16.1d.
4. **Black tee drop zone on 18th hole:** Players who hit from the Black Tee and do not cross the hazard markers on the island, are entitled to play from a drop zone which is the Men's white tee box. Drop the ball between or up-to 1 club length behind the white markers, with a penalty of 1 stroke. Rule 17.1 c applies.
5. **On the 9th 13th & 15th tees:** If it is unclear whether your tee shot has passed the hazard markers and it is unknown whether the ball is playable, to assist with speed of play, a player may play a provisional ball under rule 18.3.
6. **Lost ball or Out of Bounds:**
If a player's ball is lost or O.O.B, the player can either;
Drop a ball in the position from where the original shot was played (1 stroke penalty).
Drop a ball between where it was lost or went out of bounds and up to 1 club length of the fairway no closer to the hole (2 stroke penalty). Rule 18.2 applies.
7. **Out of Bounds:** All areas beyond the course boundary and within privately fenced properties are O.O.B. This includes all estate roads. Follow procedure as stated above in the Lost Ball or Out of Bounds section. Rule 18.2 applies.
8. **Wheel Marks:** Wheel marks made by vehicles may be treated as GUR and relief from wheel marks may be obtained without penalty under rule 16.1b.
9. **Solidly embedded stones:** If solidly embedded stones through the green interfere with the lie of the ball relief may be taken without penalty under rule 16.1b.

Distance markers are to the centre of greens.

Stakes and lines marking defined areas **Red** = Penalty area (previously water hazard)
White = Ground under Repair. **White Post with Black top** = Out of Bounds.

is permitted under Rule 16.1b.

Road/Gravel Path - Relief may be taken without

penalty, under Rule 16.1b.

Embedded Stones - Firmly embedded stones

through the green are to be treated as GUR, relief may

be taken under Rule 16.1b. Interference with a player's

stance is deemed not to be, of itself, interference under

this Rule.

Penalty Areas - All Penalty Areas are defined by Red

or Yellow posts and stakes.

Garden Beds - Garden Beds marked with white GUR

stakes MUST be treated as "Ground Under Repair" (GUR).

Play is prohibited. Relief MUST be taken under Rule 16.1b.

Areas not marked with white GUR stakes are "in play".

Staked Trees or Shrubs - If a staked tree or staked

shrub interferes with stance or swing, relief MUST be

taken under Rule 16.1b.

Sprinkler Heads - All fixed sprinkler heads and tap

covers are immovable obstructions and relief may be

obtained under Rule 16.1b. In addition, when a ball

lies in the general area, interference also exists if an

immovable obstruction is on the player's line of play

and is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and

within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take

relief under Rule 16.1b (Exception - There is no relief

under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play

that is clearly unreasonable.)
