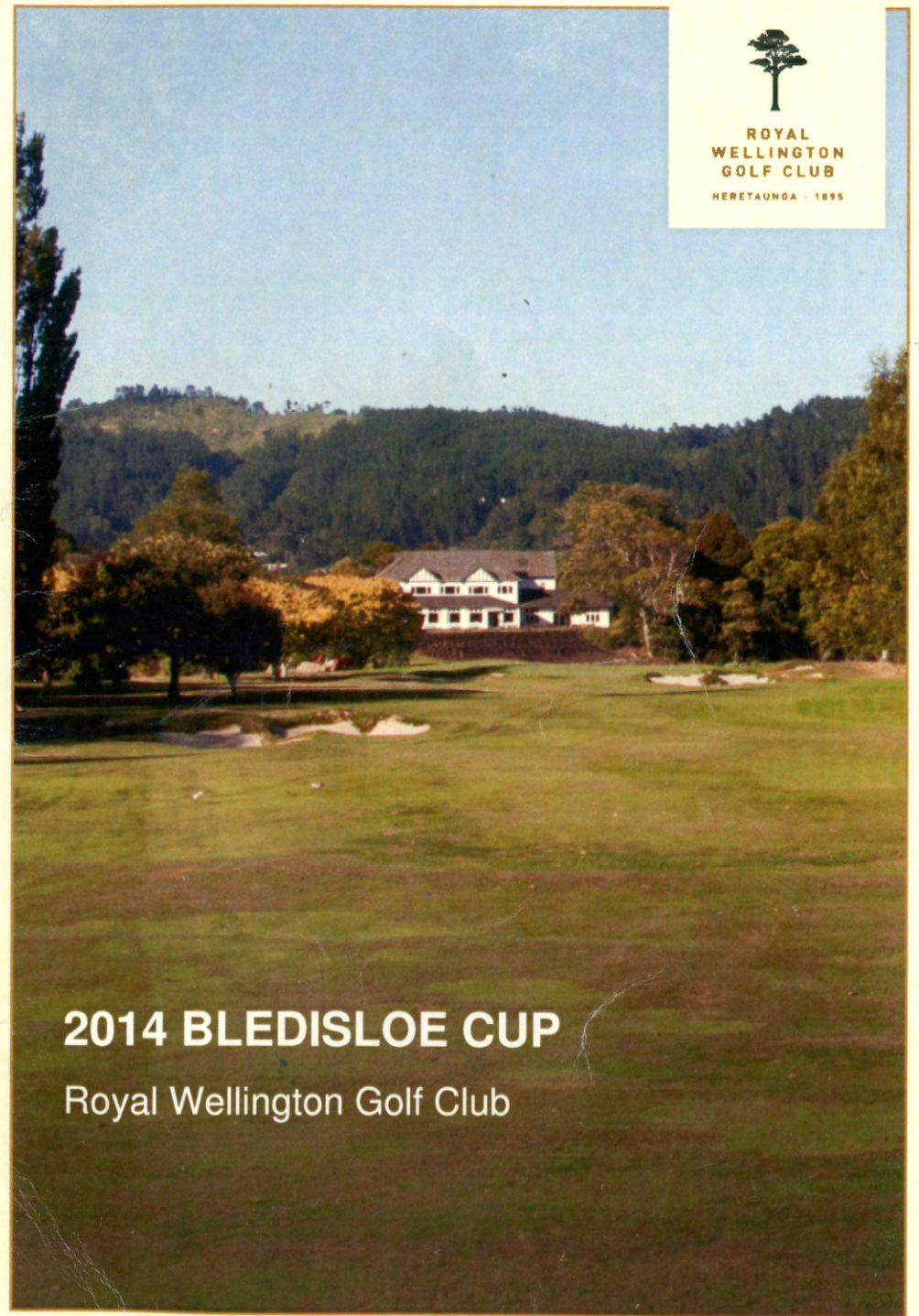

CLUB RULES

(To be read together with the Local Rules board and the score card - effective 18 July, 2014)

PLACING

Mark, lift, clean and place - 150mm on own fairway only.

EMBEDDED BALL

A ball embedded in its own pitch-mark 'through the green' may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole.

ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS IN A BUNKER (Rule 25)

A ball in a bunker that lies in a hole cast by a burrowing animal or other abnormal ground condition, as defined in Rule 25, (excluding player footprints but including channels caused by water) may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, in the bunker, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole.

ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS (Rule 25) - where the turf has become detached.

Free relief MAY be taken, if a player's ball comes to rest 'through the green' where the turf has become detached from the soil. Lift and drop the ball within one club length as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole.

WATER HAZARDS (yellow stakes) and LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (red stakes, lines and red domes)

All streams, lakes and their banks are water hazards (yellow) or lateral water hazards (red). Stakes identify the water hazards and are immovable obstructions (Rule 24-2). The margins of these hazards are defined by lines, mow cuts or furrows, which are themselves in the water hazard. A ball is in a water hazard when it lies in or any part of it touches the water hazard.

DROP ZONES IF BALL IN WATER HAZARDS (identified with white tipped stakes)

There are drop zones on holes 8 and 14.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR) – Relief MUST be taken

GUR includes:

- Areas defined by white-lined areas;
- Newly seeded areas, particularly those in and around some of the greens;
- Areas where soil etc. from the coring of greens has been laid to fill in depressions.

Relief must be taken from GUR without penalty by dropping a ball within one club-length of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole from where the ball lay within the GUR.

Exception: when a ball lies in a seam in freshly laid turf, a mark, lift, clean and place within 150mm is permitted.

OUT OF BOUNDS (OB) (Rule 27)

Out of bounds is defined by boundary fences or furrow marked with a white stake and line of sight between white stakes. The paved area adjacent to the Clubhouse is out of bounds

USE OF DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES.

A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used."
