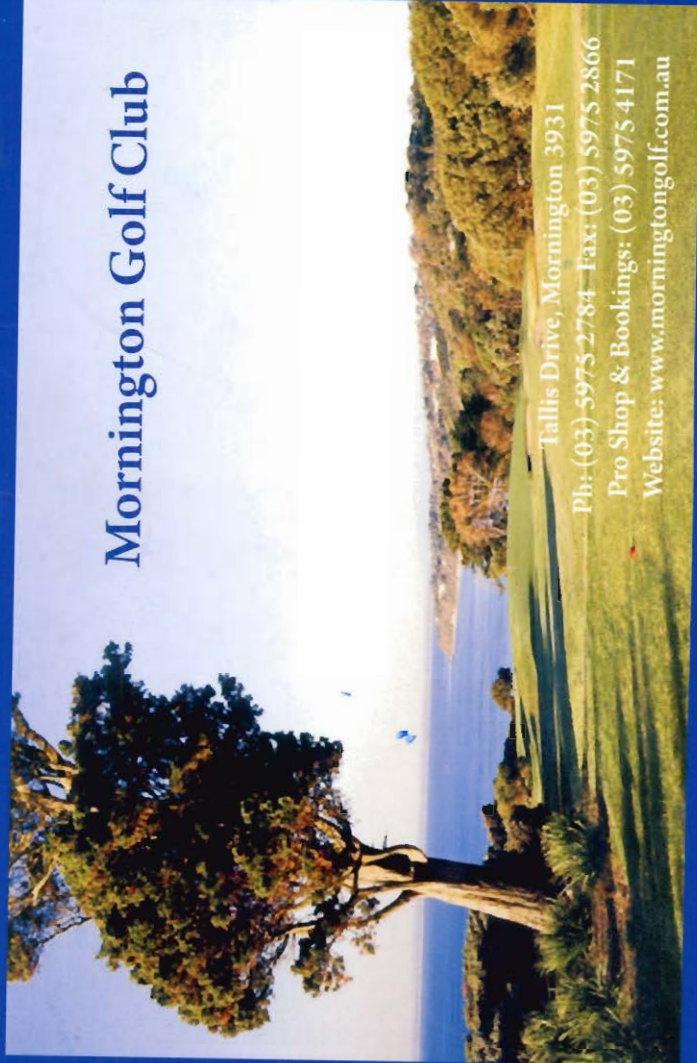

LOCAL RULES - To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any temporary local rules

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

All ground beyond the Club boundary fence.

2. STAKED TREES AND SHRUBS

If a tree or shrub, that is either staked and/or protected by a tree guard, interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted without penalty.

3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24)

(a) All stakes defining GUR areas, water hazards, lateral water hazards and stakes (and/or guards) supporting staked trees/shrubs are deemed to be immovable obstructions.

(b) Immovable Obstructions on or within two club-lengths of the Putting Green. In addition to relief available under Rule 24-2, Specimen Local Rule 6 of Appendix 1, Part B, page 134, of the Rules of Golf may provide additional relief.

4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25)

The following areas are defined as Ground Under Repair/Abnormal Ground Conditions:

- (a) Areas defined by white stakes, white lines, and GUR signage.
- (b) Washways in bunkers and at the margins of bunkers.
- (c) The garden beds that adjoin the clubhouse wall and the

rose garden between the Pro Shop and the clubhouse.

NOTE: All other garden areas are an integral part of the course. No relief without penalty is available from them unless Local Rule No. 2 applies or an immovable obstruction causes interference (Rule 24). Woodchips on garden areas are deemed to be loose impediments.

5. EMBEDDED BALL - THROUGH THE GREEN

Through the green, a ball that is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground may be lifted, without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. Specimen Local Rule 4a of Appendix 1, Part B, page 131, of the Rules of Golf applies.

6. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

7. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

For all play at this course, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. Specimen Local Rule 9 of Appendix 1, Part B, page 140, of the Rules of Golf applies.

LOCAL RULES

- OUT OF BOUNDS** - The Practice fairway and Car Park are deemed to be Out of Bounds. The black chain wire fence on the Northern side of the 18th West fairway and the white posts along the line of the Cypress trees determine the boundary.
- STAKED TREES** - If a staked tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed under Rule 24-2b (1) (immovable obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
NOTE - Stakes or wire protecting young trees are immovable obstructions.
- SPRINKLER HEADS** etc. Specimen Local Rule No. 6 in Appendix to Rules of Golf (classifying FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS as immovable obstructions and providing additional relief) applies. Identical relief may be taken from TAP COVERS.

LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any temporary local rules.)

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)

- Beyond any fence bounding the course
- The Clubhouse and car park, including roads and paths, practice putting greens and garden beds bordered by brick paving, in these areas.
- The work shed area between the 7th, 10th and 12th holes, as defined by fencing and/or white stakes with black tops.

2. Staked Trees and Shrubs (including guard/stakes)

If such a tree/shrub interferes with a player's stance or the area of the intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

3. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

The following items are defined as immovable obstructions:

- Fixed Sprinkler Heads/Tap Covers Close to the Putting Green. Specimen Local Rule 6 of Appendix 1, Part B of the Rules of Golf applies.
- All stakes defining GUR areas, Water Hazards and Lateral Water Hazards and stakes (and/or guards) supporting staked trees/shrubs.
- All constructed pathways on course are to be treated as immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken without penalty in accordance to rule 24.2.

4. Stones in Bunkers

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

5. Ground Under Repair (Rule 25)

Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes and/or white lines. (Note: stakes are immovable obstructions). All tree stumps remaining from recently removed trees are defined as Ground Under Repair. Relief may be taken without penalty in accordance with rule 25-1.

6. Distance Measuring Devices

For all play at this course, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. Specimen Local Rule 9 of Appendix 1, Part B, page 140, of the Rules of Golf applies.

4. Cart Paths and Internal Roads.

All cart paths and internal roads with artificial surfaces are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 24-2. This includes the road parallel to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th holes. Note: All other paths and tracks are an integral part of the course.

5. Stones in Bunkers

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

6. Ground Under Repair (G.U.R.)

All areas, the margins of which are defined by white stakes/lines and/or signage are G.U.R. Relief may be obtained under Rule 25-1. Note: All stakes defining GUR areas are immovable obstructions.

7. GPS - Distance Measuring Devices

For all play at this course, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only and which is designed primarily for this purpose. Specimen Local Rule 9, Appendix 1, Part B of the Rules of Golf applies.

2. Trees and Shrubs defined by guards/stakes

If a tree/shrub that is either staked and/or protected by a tree guard interferes with a player's stance or the area of the intended swing, the ball **must** be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with Rule 24-2. Note: All stakes or guards protecting trees or shrubs are immovable obstructions.

3. Fixed Sprinkler Heads, Tap Covers and Grates.

All fixed sprinkler heads, tap covers and grates are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 24-2. Additional relief may be taken under Specimen Local Rule 6, Appendix 1, Part B of the Rules of Golf, for immovable obstructions close to the putting green.

4. Cart Paths and Internal Roads.

All cart paths and internal roads with artificial surfaces are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 24-2. Note: All other paths and tracks are an integral part of the course.

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

- Out of Bounds:** To include the following-
 - Beyond the fence bounding the course.
 - The practice fairway adjacent to the 18th hole as defined by white stakes with black tops.
 - The clubhouse, carparks, gardens west of driveway and entrance adjoining the clubhouse.
- Trees and Shrubs:** If a staked tree or a staked shrub interferes with a player's stance or area of his intended swing, the player **MUST** take relief as provided in Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted. The stakes (and/or guards) are immovable obstructions.
- Water Hazards:** Water Hazards are defined by yellow stakes and Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red stakes. The stakes are immovable obstructions.
- Putting Greens 8th and 16th Holes:**
The putting greens at the 8th and 16th holes are to be treated as a single green unless the player whose ball lies beyond its neck elects to use a club other than a putter in which case Rule 25-3 (ball on wrong putting green) shall apply.
- Stones in Bunkers:**
"Stones in bunkers are declared as movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)."
- Fixed Sprinkler Heads and Tap Covers:**
Fixed sprinkler heads and tap covers are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under rule 24-2. In addition specimen Local Rule 6 Appendix 1 rules of golf also applies.
- Distance Measuring Devices:**
"Specimen Local Rule 9, Appendix 1 Rules of Golf also applies."
- Paths and Tracks:**
All paths and tracks are deemed to be an integral part of the course.

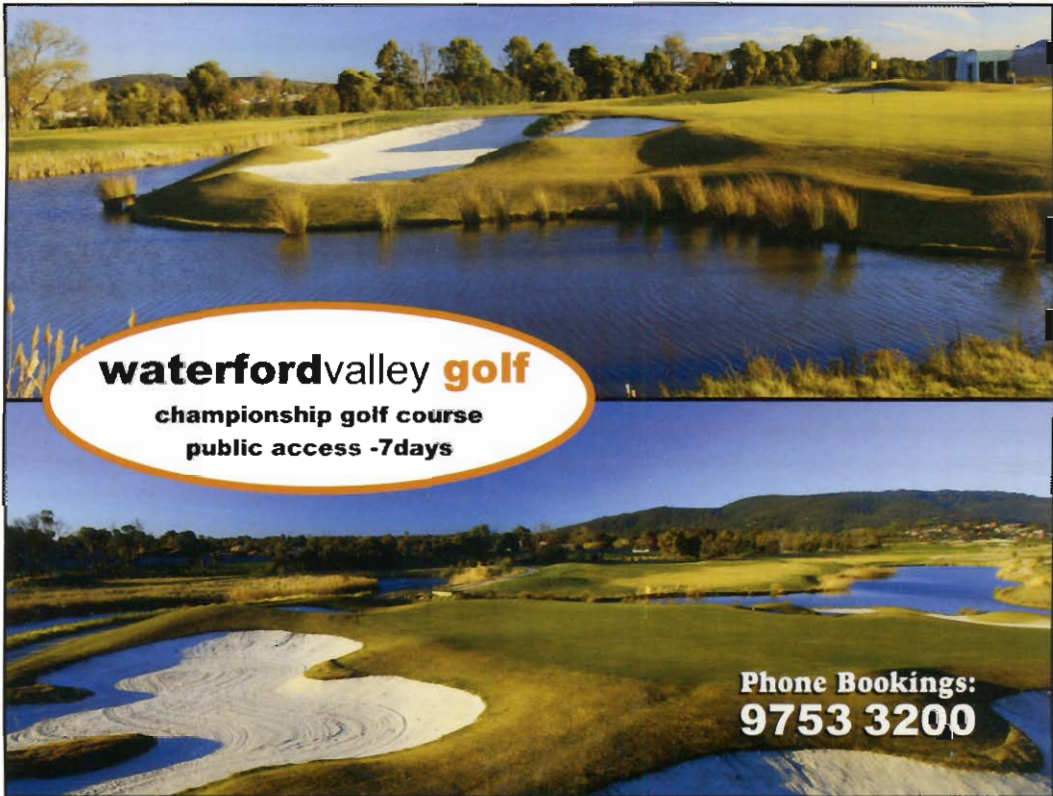

LOCAL RULES

- OUT OF BOUNDS** - The Practice fairway and Car Park are deemed to be Out of Bounds. The black chain wire fence on the Northern side of the 18th West fairway and the white posts along the line of the Cypress trees determine the boundary.
- STAKED TREES** - If a staked tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed under Rule 24-2b (1) (immovable obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
NOTE - Stakes or wire protecting young trees are immovable obstructions.
- SPRINKLER HEADS** etc. Specimen Local Rule No. 6 in Appendix to Rules of Golf (classifying **FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS** as immovable obstructions and providing additional relief) applies. Identical relief may be taken from **TAP COVERS**.

EMERGENCY TELEPHONE DEDUCT HANDICAP

LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any temporary local rules.)

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)

The following areas are out of bounds:

- (a) All ground outside the boundary fences.
- (b) Bitumen-surfaced car park area and
- (c) The water storage on the 17th hole as marked by white stakes with black tops.

Players are encouraged to play a provisional ball if they believe their ball may be out of bounds.

2. Staked Trees and Shrubs (including guard/stakes)

If a staked tree/shrub under two club-lengths in height interferes with a player's stance or the area of the intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

3. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

The following items are defined as immovable obstructions:

- Grates, Sprinkler Heads & Tap Covers. Specimen Local Rule 6 of Appendix 1, Part B of the Rules of Golf also applies for immovable obstructions close to the putting green.
- All stakes defining GUR areas and stakes (and/or guards) supporting staked trees/shrubs.
- All paths/bitumen roads adjacent to the clubhouse (including the entrance road).

Note: All other course paths and roads are an integral part of the course.

4. Stones in Bunkers

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

5. Ground Under Repair (Rule 25)

- (i) Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes/lines and/or signage.
- (ii) All defined garden areas surrounding the clubhouse. Play is prohibited. Relief must be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1.
