

LOCAL RULES

(to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

- 1. Out of Bounds** - All ground beyond the clubs boundary fence and the line of black topped white stakes on the right hand side of the 3rd and 4th holes, beyond and to the right hand side of the 17th green and the practice fairway.
- 2. Trees and Shrubs** - If a tree, shrub or stump under two club lengths interferes with the players stance or area of the intended swing, the player must take relief and provided in rule 16.1.
- 3. Sprinkler Heads** - All sprinkler heads and turf valves are immovable obstructions. Relief from interference by them may be obtained under rule 16.1.

In addition, if such an obstruction on or within 2 club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played, intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows:- If the ball lies off the putting green (but not in a Hazard) and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lays, which:

- A. Is not nearer the hole*
- B. Avoids such interference*
- C. Is not in a hazard*

- 4. Stake Markings** - All stakes are immovable obstructions. The player must take relief as in rule 16.1.
Water Hazard - Yellow stakes
Lateral Water Hazard - Red Stakes
Ground under repair - White Stakes, lines or signs

- 5.** The road running through the centre of the course and adjacent drain is GUR, player may take relief Rule 16.1

Note: Blue pine posts indicate 150 M from centre of fairway to centre of green.

LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the rules of golf)

OUT OF BOUNDS

All ground beyond the club's boundary fence and the concrete area adjacent to the 18th hole is out of bounds.

VALVE CONTROL STATIONS

A ball lying within one club length of any valve control station or exposed water pipe may be lifted and dropped without penalty - one club length from where the ball lay (not nearer the hole).

EMBEDDED STONES

Through the green, solidly embedded stones may be treated as Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16.1).

SPRINKLER HEADS

All pop-up sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions (Rule 16.1). If such an obstruction (within one club length of the putting green of the hole being played) intervenes on the line of play, the player may obtain relief (without penalty) within one club length of the intervening obstruction, provided (a) it is not dropped nearer the hole, (b) it avoids such intervention, (c) it is not on the putting green.

STAKED TREES

If a staked or planted tree (under two club lengths in height) interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted and dropped without penalty. (Rule 16.1).

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS

Ant's nests, tracks, wheel marks, animal holes, ground under repair, immovable obstructions or temporary water are all Abnormal Course Conditions. (Rule 16.1)

STAKES

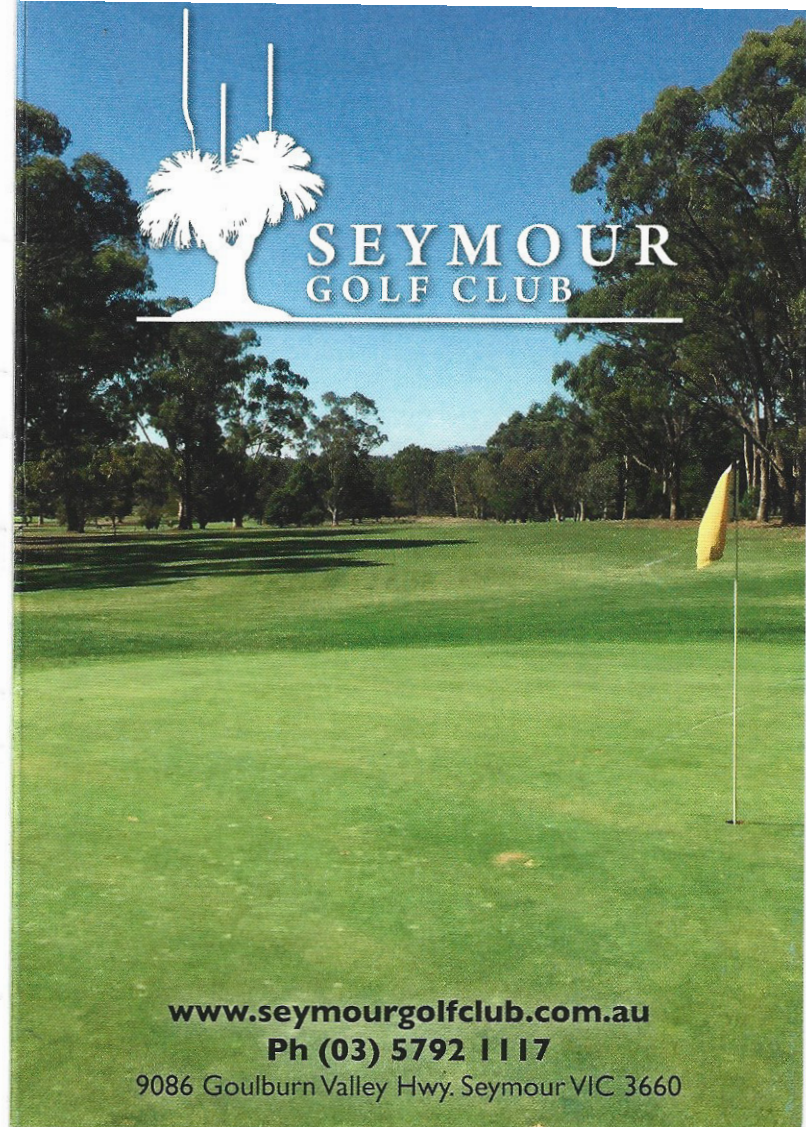
Through the green, all stakes (except those defining out of bounds) are to be treated as immovable obstructions (Rule 16.1). Stakes are not to be removed.

STAKE COLOURS

White = Abnormal Course Conditions Red = Lateral water hazard
Yellow = Water hazard Blue = 150 metre markers Purple = 100 metre markers.

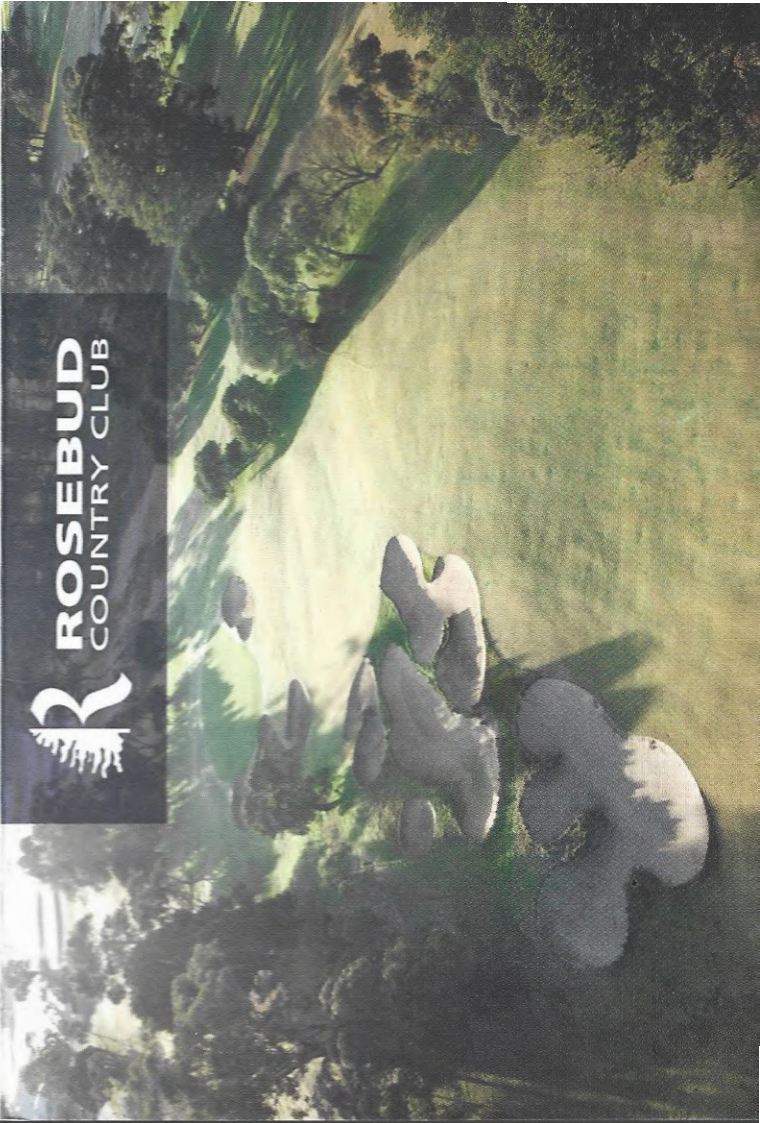

LOCAL RULES

(to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any Temporary Local Rules)

1. Out of Bounds

The area beyond the line defined by white pegs with black tops and all ground beyond the Club's boundary fence, within the fence-line of the internal maintenance compound and practice fairway.

2. Staked Trees

The young trees identified by stakes are no play zones:

- If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under **Rule 16.1f**.
- If the ball lies in a penalty area, and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player must take relief either with penalty under **Rule 17.1e** or with free relief under **Rule 17.1e(2)**.

3. Ground Under Repair

All areas marked with white lines, signs or white stakes are G.U.R. If a player's ball lies in the area, or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his/her intended swing, the player **may** take relief under Rule 16.1. If a sign indicates that play is prohibited, the player **must** drop away from the area under Rule 16.1.

4. Turf Nursery

The Turf Nursery located between the 7th South Fairway and the 17th South Fairway is a no play zone that is to be treated as an abnormal course condition. Free relief **must** be taken from interference by the no play zone under **Rule 16.1f**.

5. Obstructions

All stakes, ropes, hoses, sprinklers, protective screens and drain caps on the course are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under **Rule 16.1**. Relief is not allowed to be taken under **Rule 15.2**.

6. Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green (Sprinklers Heads)

Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under **Rule 16.1**.

The player also has these extra options to take relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play:

Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under **Rule 16.1b** if an immovable obstruction is:

- On the line of play, and is;
- Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
- Within two club-lengths of the ball.

Exception – No Relief if Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable.

There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

7. Operating Sprinklers

Where the sprinkler interferes with your swing or stance, relief may be obtained under Rule 16.1b (G.U.R.) at the nearest point from the perimeter of the spray. Sprinkler equipment must not be interfered with.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:

Stroke Play – Two Strokes. Match Play – Loss of Hole.

Siren Warnings: One Long Siren Blast – Play Suspended

Two Long Blasts – Resume Play

Three Short Blasts – Play Abandoned

Sprinkler head distance markers are measured to the centre of the green.

Motorised Carts must be kept at least ten metres from any penalty area, bunker, tee or green.

LOCAL RULES

to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf

1. Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions: Rule 15.2.a applies.
2. Distance measuring devices are permitted to be used during a competition round. However, a device that measures other conditions is not permitted. e.g. wind speed and direction, slope, club selection etc. A multi-functional device such as a smartphone may be used provided it is only used to gauge distance.
3. The sand aprons at the entry point of the bunkers are an integral part of the bunker and are to be treated as such.
4. Immoveable obstructions: includes maintenance buildings, fixed course signs and barriers, all course stakes, cart paths and sleeper walls, hoses, sprinklers. Relief MAY be taken under Rule 16.1a.
5. Garden beds are an integral part of the course. Play ball as it lies or proceed under Rule 19.2.

6. GUR: is defined by white lines and are NO PLAY ZONES. Relief MUST be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1(f).
7. Out of bounds is defined by boundary fences and white stakes with black tops.
8. The Red penalty area on the 17th Hole is defined by red stakes and the left edge of the concrete path and extends to infinity beyond that point. Relief MAY be taken using Rule 17.1d(1) or 17.1d(3). This penalty area only applies to the 17th Hole.
9. Greenside sprinkler heads: If such an obstruction on the hole being played intervenes on the line of play, relief MAY be taken under Rule 16.1b. The obstruction must be within 2 club lengths from the ball and within 2 club lengths of the green.
10. If a staked tree or staked shrub interferes with a player's stance or intended swing, relief MUST be taken under Rule 16.1a.

Penalty for breach of Local Rule:

Match Play - Loss of Hole. Stroke Play - Two Strokes

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Eagle Ridge may request patrons to leave the property for inappropriate behaviour or slow play.

Playing time to complete each nine holes is 2 hours and 15 minutes.

All people on the golf course must adhere to the course attire standards.

Please replace all divots, ball marks on greens and rake bunkers.

Practising on the course is prohibited.

THE DUNES GOLF LINKS LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with Rules of Golf January 2019.

1. OUT OF BOUNDS - all ground beyond fences and stakes. Rule 18.2**2. ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS** - Rule 16.1

- All stakes, signs, ropes, course maintenance equipment, stakes/trees and 150m markers are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed.
- All roads and defined paths, even if not artificially surfaced, are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed.
- Relief may be taken if an immovable obstruction on the line of play is within Club-length of the putting green and within 2 club-lengths of the ball. Rule 16.1b.
- The areas (i) beyond the green-side border of the path behind the 9th hole and the adjacent green and (ii) the grass nursery on the left of the 16th, and (iii) near the 4th between the 2nd and 3rd holes, are No Play Zones that are to be treated as abnormal ground conditions. Free relief must be taken. Rule 16-1f Orange dropping stakes may be provided. See 13-4.
- Ground Under Repair may be marked with solid or dashed white lines.

3. PENALTY AREA - Rule 17.1

The area beyond the 18th green marked with red stakes is a red penalty area. Orange dropping stakes are provided. See 13-4.

- 4. DROPPING STAKES** - In addition to red stakes available under the applicable rules, Drop within one club-length of the orange stake. The ball must be dropped into zone to rest within this area. The dropping zone is defined under Rule 14.2.

LOCAL RULES Read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any Temporary Rules

1 OUT OF BOUNDS: (Rule 18.2). Beyond any *boundary object*, all permanently sealed car parks, and the maintenance complex. *Internal O.O.B* marked by white stakes with black tops are located adjacent to the Bowling Green & Tennis Court area, and on the 17th North where any ball finishing to the left of these stakes is O.O.B.

2 PENALTY AREAS: (Rule 17). These are defined as red or yellow *penalty areas* by stakes, pavers, or lines of the corresponding colour. Relief options are listed under Rule 17.1d. When the ball last crossed the edge of a red *penalty area* on holes 2S, 3S, 5S, and 10S, on penalty of one stroke, the player may also drop a ball on the opposite edge of the *penalty area*, with both reference points the same distance from the hole.

(a) **Playing Ball Provisionally Under Model Local Rule B-3**

If there is doubt whether a ball is in the red *penalty area* on hole 13S, the player may play a *provisional ball* under Rule 18.3, using all options of Rule 17.1d. If the original ball is found outside the *penalty area* it must be played, or if inside the *penalty area* it may be played as it lies, but otherwise, the provisional ball becomes the ball in play.

3 ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: (See Rule 16 for Definition and Relief Options)

(1) **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** (Free relief under Rule 16.1)

(a) Include all artificially surfaced roadways, paths, boardwalks, and the pavers, stakes, rails and associated ropes defining *penalty areas*, *internal O.O.B*, *G.U.R.* and *no play zones*. Path matting, wooden control barriers, course furniture, and all drinking fountains are also *immovable obstructions*. All stone walls and other stone works, are *integral objects* and not *obstructions*.

(b) **Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green - Line of Play Interference.** In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists for a ball in the *general area* if

an *immovable obstruction* on or within two club lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball, is on the player's reasonable *line of play*. Relief is available under Rule 16.1b.

(2) **GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** Defined as any area of the course bounded by white lines or white stakes.

(3) **NO PLAY ZONES (NPZ):** Free relief must be taken from interference by these *no play zones*, deemed abnormal course conditions, under Rule 16.1f.

(a) **Trees and Shrubs.** Trees and shrubs that are staked, guarded, or otherwise marked are *no play zones* which include the stake and any wrapping. For a ball in a *penalty area*, relief must be taken under Rule 17.1e.

(b) **The Clubhouse Buildings & Environs.** The Clubhouse buildings, their associated structures, paving and formal garden beds. The reference point for free relief under Rule 16.1b must be on the green side of the NPZ, and in the *general area* of the hole being played.

(c) **The Remote Accommodation.** The NPZ is defined by the green tipped white stakes.

4 SANDY WASTES: The sandy areas located throughout the golf course that do not have rakes in or adjacent to them are part of the *general area*, and are not *bunkers*. No relief for *embedded* ball.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

Stroke Play – Two strokes. Match Play – Loss of hole. Unless otherwise noted Distances on sprinkler heads are in metres to the Front, Centre, and Back of the green.

Buggies, Carts or similar equipment are not permitted on the Greens.

Siren: Play is to be suspended immediately when the Siren is sounded. (Rule 5.7b). All players must return to the Clubhouse.

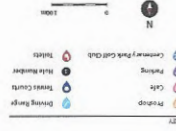

- 1. Out of Bounds: All ground beyond boundary fences (Rule 27)
- 2. Tree and Shrubs: If a staked tree or shrub interferes with a player's stance or swing, the player must take relief as provided in Rule 24-2b - no penalty.
- 3. Sprinkler Heads: All sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 24-2 - no penalty.
- 4. Ground Under Repair (GUR): The player may take relief as provided in Rule 24-1b - ball to be dropped within one club's length no nearer the hole - no penalty.
- 5. Wheel Marks: Through the green, wheel marks made by any motorised vehicle may be treated as GUR (Rule 25-1b) - no penalty.
- 6. Cross Drains: Marked (white stakes) may lift and drop one club length, no nearer the hole - no penalty.
- 7. 150m post and all hazard stakes are immovable obstructions. Rule 24-2, 150m posts are measured to the centre of the greens. Please observe the etiquette of golf:
 - Keep bugles off tees and greens
 - Ball lost - call player through
 - Repair divots & ball marks (sand is provided for fairway divots)
 - Smooth out bunkers
 - Avoid slow play
 - Dress standards are to be observed
 - Players must give way to ground staff

Any staked tree that interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b (Immovable Obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when lifted, without penalty.

Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2):

The following items are defined as immovable obstructions:

- (a) Sprinkler Heads, Grates and Tap Covers – In addition Specimen Local Rule 4 of Appendix 1 Part A of the Rules of Golf also applies to immovable obstructions close to the putting green.
- (b) All stakes defining GUR areas, Water Hazards and Lateral Water Hazards.

Ground Under Repair (Rule 25):

The following areas are defined as Ground Under Repair:

- (a) Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes, white lines and/or GUR signage – relief MUST be taken.
- (b) Solidly embedded stones through the green – relief MAY be taken.
- (c) Kangaroo damage to bunkers: Marks left by kangaroos may be treated as GUR and relief MAY be taken
- (d) Washaways in bunkers – relief MAY be taken

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Stroke Play – 2 strokes, Match Play – Loss of Hole

Distance Measuring Devices: A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. 1. **OUT OF BOUNDS** -The Practice fairway and Car Park are deemed to be Out of Bounds. The black chain wire fence on the Northern side of the 18th West fairway and the white posts along the line of the Cypress trees determine the boundary.
2. **STAKED TREES** - If a staked tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed under Rule 24-2b (1) (immovable obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
NOTE - Stakes or wire protecting young trees are immovable obstructions.
3. **SPRINKLER HEADS** etc.
Specimen Local Rule No. 6 in Appendix to Rules of Golf (classifying FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS as immovable obstructions and providing additional relief) applies. Identical relief may be taken from TAP COVERS.

From its earliest days in 1898, the Yarra Yarra Golf Club has been a part of Melbourne's history. The Club's founders first played on a rough, nine-hole course at Eaglemont in 1898, on the same terrain that inspired Arthur Streeton's famous painting Golden Summers (1889). Eaglemont Golf Club, as it was originally known, was also avant garde in that male and female members enjoyed equal rights from the outset.

When encroaching suburbia made the scene less idyllic, members found a new home in 1911 at nearby Rosanna on the banks of the Yarra, the Aboriginal word for flowing. There the Club was renamed to reflect the new surroundings and stayed until 1927 when the constantly expanding metropolis again forced a move. This time to Bentleigh East, well south of the river and in the heart of the famous Melbourne Sandbelt.

Alex Russell was the inspired choice of course designer and his legacy is a classic design from the golden era that has been preserved almost in its entirety for more than 80 years.

OUT OF BOUNDS:

- All ground beyond boundary fences
- The maintenance area adjacent to the 6th hole and 7th tee including all associated buildings, equipment, driveways and surrounding fences.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS – RULE 16.1

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

Relief may be taken:

- Artificially surfaced roads, car parks, paths and gutters.
- Penalty Area stakes, GUR and Dropping stakes, ropes and associated stakes, signs and hoops.

Relief must be taken:

- If a player's ball comes to rest on or beyond the car park or the clubhouse, gardens and paths within the boundary of the road surrounding the Clubhouse when playing the 2nd, 7th or 9th holes, relief without penalty **MUST** be taken either within one club-length of the nearest point of relief on the green side of the hole being played or by dropping the ball within one club-length of the nearest dropping stake of the hole being played (even if the dropping stake is nearer the hole than where the ball originally lay).

GROUND UNDER REPAIR:

The following areas are GUR and are **NO PLAY ZONES**:

- Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes, white lines, GUR signage and/or accompanying rope.
- The garden bed surrounding the flagpole in front of the Clubhouse
- The garden bed and the fountain on the putting green adjacent to the clubhouse
- The Clubhouse, gardens and paths within the boundary of the road surrounding the Clubhouse.

STAKED TREES

Staked Trees / Staked Shrubs under 2 club lengths in height, including the stake and any wrapping, are **NO PLAY ZONES** and are Ground Under Repair.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (EG SPRINKLER HEADS) CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS – LINE OF PLAY INTERFERENCE

Rule 16.1b applies to immovable obstructions close to putting green. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green and is within two club-lengths of the ball. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

RED PENALTY AREA BEHIND 10TH GREEN

The pond at the rear of the 10th green is a red penalty area. Players may proceed under Rule 17.1, or as an additional option when playing the 10th hole a ball may be dropped within one club-length of the nearest dropping stake even if the dropping stake is nearer the hole than where the ball originally crossed the margin of the red penalty area.

AUTOSCORE CARDS:

If two different scores are recorded for the same hole, (example: the number "5" is recorded in the autoscore box but 4 has been written down) the higher score will count.

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for a breach of a Local Rule is the General Penalty

TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH
THE RULES OF GOLF

Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2):

is defined by -

- The fence bounding the course.
- White stakes with Black tops - practice fairway adjacent to the 18th fairway.
- The clubhouse (including paved areas) & carparks.

Alternative to Stroke & Distance:

When a player's ball has not been found, or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds the player may proceed under the Stroke and Distance Local Rule for a **penalty of two strokes**, rather than proceeding under stroke and distance. This Local Rule is not available if a provisional ball has been played.

Shared Green 8th & 16th:

The green serving holes **8 & 16** is considered to be two separate greens divided by **the neck of the green**.

A player who elects to use any club other than a putter, and has interference with the portion of the green for the hole not being played, is on a wrong green and must take relief under Rule 13.1f.

Red Penalty Areas (Rule 17):

Red penalty areas are defined by red stakes. These stakes, unless the ball rests in the penalty area, are to be treated as immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Protection of Young (Sapling) Trees:

Young trees identified with a supporting stake are no play zones:

- If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course, other than in a penalty area, and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.
- The stakes (and / or) tree guards are immovable obstructions.

Fixed Sprinkler Heads and Tap Covers:

All fixed sprinkler heads and tap covers are immovable obstructions. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception - There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

Suspension and Resumption of Play:

An immediate suspension of play will be signalled by a **continuous siren of 15 seconds**. All other suspensions will be signalled by **four sirens blasts**. In either case, resumption of play will be signalled by **two siren blasts**. See Rule 5.7b.

Paths & Tracks:

All paths and tracks are deemed to be an integral object.

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the General Penalty.



LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS - Ground outside the Club boundary fences is out of bounds.
2. STAKED TREES - If a staked tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed under Rule 24-2b (1) (immovable obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
NOTE - Stakes or wire protecting young trees are immovable obstructions.
