### Narooma Golf Club LOCAL RULES

- Out of Bounds:** (i) defined by course boundary fences or white pegs/posts with black tops; (ii) the clubhouse structures, the tar sealed car park and the greenkeeper's compounds.
  - A ball striking overhead wires on the 10th and 16th MUST be replayed without penalty.
  - If a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of intended swing, he must take relief as provided in Rule 24-2b (1).
  - If, on holes 2 and 3, the ball is on the course proper outside the hazard and the player's stance is inside the hazard lines, the ball may be dropped without penalty at the nearest point of relief so that the player's stance is fully within the course.
  - Landscaped garden areas, pathways and roadways are to be treated as immovable obstructions and relief is to be taken at the nearest point under Rule 24-2b.
  - Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.
  - Relief for an embedded ball is allowed "through the green."
  - Distance measuring devices are permitted.
  - Rakes are to be placed OUTSIDE bunkers in the direction of play.
  - Water Hazards (including Lateral Water Hazards) (Rule 26):** Water hazards are defined yellow markers. Where yellow lines are in existence, they define the margin. Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red markers. Where red lines are in existence, they define the margin.
- Flags on greens:** RED flag (front), YELLOW flag (middle), WHITE flag (back).

## LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited and any temporary Local Rules)

1. **Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)**
  - 1.1 Beyond any fence defining the boundaries of the course.
  - 1.2 Beyond the inside line of any white stakes with black tops defining the boundary of the course.
  - 1.3 During play of the 18<sup>th</sup> hole only, the white stakes with the black dots on the left side of the 18<sup>th</sup> hole.  
Note: The stakes are immovable obstructions during play of the 1<sup>st</sup> hole.
2. **Water Hazards (including Lateral Water Hazards) (Rule 26)**
  - 2.1 Water Hazards are defined by yellow stakes or blacks.
  - 2.2 Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red stakes or blocks  
Note: The stakes are Immovable Obstructions.
3. **Ground under Repair (Rule 25)**
  - 3.1 Areas encircled by white paint e.g. dots, broken lines, or unbroken lines.
  - 3.2 Except in a hazard, clearly defined wheel ruts made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle.
4. **Gardens – Play prohibited (Rule 25)**

All gardens are GUR play prohibited. Relief must be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1.
5. **Roads and Paths (Rule 24-2)**

The artificial surfaces and sides of roads and paths (includes gravel paths) are immovable obstructions.
6. **Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green (e.g. Sprinkler heads)**

The specimen Local Rule in Appendix 1 of the Rules of Golf applies – see pages 130-131
7. **Staked Trees and Shrubs**

If a tree or shrub, that is either staked and/or protected by a tree guard, interferes with the player's stance or the area of their intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b (Immovable Obstruction)  
Note: The stakes are Immovable Obstructions.
8. **Stones in Bunkers**

Stones in Bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)
9. **Power Lines and Poles**

If a ball strikes an elevated power line or cable on the course, the stroke must be cancelled and replayed without penalty (see Rule 20-5)
10. **Embedded Ball - Extended to Through the Green**

The specimen Local Rule on page 127 is in effect.
11. **Distance Measuring Devices**

The specimen Local Rule on page 136 is in effect for all play during competitions.

## AUSTRALIAN RULES OF GOLF APPLY EXCEPT WHERE LOCAL RULES PREVAIL

1. Only ornamental trees and shrubs with a white tag attached that interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with rule 24-2 b (1) (immovable obstruction).
2. A ball striking powerlines must be replayed without penalty.
3. Fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from them may be obtained in accordance with rule 24-2 b (1).
4. All roads, paths, and protective screens are immovable obstructions (rule 24.2 b (1)). Formed gardens must be treated as GUR. Note: Line of sight relief does not apply to protective screens. The mounds on either side of the 10th are an integral part of the course.
5. Drop zone for hazard in front of 3rd tee. When playing the 2nd hole only, if a ball comes to rest in the hazard in front of the 3rd tee and the player elects to drop out, the next stroke must be played from the marked "drop zone", under penalty of one stroke.
6. Wheel tracks. A ball lying in a wheel track made by heavy course machinery may be lifted and dropped without penalty at the nearest point of relief, which is not nearer the hole, in a hazard or on a green.
7. Practice area defined by blue stakes and the practice bunker. A ball coming to rest in a divot hole, crack or the bunker in a practice area defined by blue stakes may be lifted and dropped without penalty.

**LOCAL RULES** To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf. (Check Notice Board for temporary rules.)

**1. Free drop from all Gardens and regeneration areas**  
 A ball that comes to rest in a garden or regeneration area, identified by the presence of wood chips or formed boundaries, may be lifted and dropped nearest point of relief no nearer to the hole without penalty, with the exception to this rule being the large regeneration area situated between the 23rd and 20th Holes. This area is classified as a "Lateral Hazard" and should be treated accordingly. See Rule 26-1 of the Rules of Golf.

**2. Stones in bunkers**  
 Stones in bunkers may be treated as moveable obstructions. (Rule 24-1 applies).

**3. Drop Zones**  
 On the 5th hole, when playing from the Blue tee, a drop zone is situated to the left of the hazard in front of the white tee. This drop zone can be utilised if a ball has entered the hazard from the Blue tee.

  2. If a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing, he must take relief as provided in Rule 24-2B (1).
  3. Landscaped garden areas, pathways and roadways are to be treated as immovable obstructions and relief is to be taken at the nearest point under Rule 24-2b.
  4. Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions.
  5. Relief for an embedded ball is allowed "through the green".
  6. Distance measuring devices are permitted.
  7. Rakes are to be placed inside bunkers in direction of play.
  8. Sprinkler heads, within 2 club lengths of a green, interfering with line of play - nearest point of relief, not nearer hole.
- Please respect the environmental values of this course**

  - Reducing trampling by not searching for lost balls once they have entered bush areas.

# LOCAL RULES (To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf.)

**1. OUT OF BOUNDS**

- Defined by course boundary fences or white pegs/posts with black tops.
- The clubhouse structures, the tar sealed car park and greenkeeper's compounds.

**2. OVERHEAD WIRES**

A ball striking overhead wires on the 10th and 16th MUST be replayed without penalty

**3. STAKED TREES**

If a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of intended swing, he must take relief as provided in Rule 24-2B (1).

**4. HOLE 2 & 3**

If, on holes 2 and 3, the ball is on the course proper outside the hazard and the player's stance is inside the hazard lines, the ball be dropped without penalty at the nearest point of relief so that the player's stance is fully within the course.

**5. LANDSCAPED GARDEN AREAS**

Landscaped garden areas, pathways and roadways are to be treated as immovable obstructions and relief is to be taken at the nearest point under Rule 24-2b.

**6. STONES IN BUNKERS**

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions

**7. EMBEDDED BALLS**

Relief for an embedded ball is allowed "through the green".

**8. MEASURING DEVICES**

Distance measuring devices are permitted.

**9. BUNKER RAKES**

Rakes are to be placed OUTSIDE bunkers in the direction of play.

**10. WATER HAZARDS**

Water Hazards; (including Lateral Water Hazards) (Rule 26) Water hazards are defined by yellow markers. Where yellow lines are in existence, they define the margin. Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red markers. Where red lines are in existence, they define the margin.

**11. SPRINKLER HEADS NEAR GREENS**

If a ball lies through the green and a sprinkler head on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the lines of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows. The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay not nearer the hole. Rule 24-2 applies.

Flags on Greens: Red Flag (front), Yellow Flag (middle), White Flag (Back)

Penalty for Breach of Local Rule - Stroke Play: 2 strokes - Match Play: Loss of Hole
