**1.** The course is defined by the boundary fence. The carpark and beyond the fence at the rear of the 18<sup>th</sup> hole is also out of bounds as is the clubhouse and cart shed area as defined by the black and white posts.

**2. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)**  
 (1) Red Penalty Areas are defined by red stakes, lines, or plates.

**3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16)**  
 (1) All stakes defining G.U.R., distances, and Penalty Areas

**4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16)**  
 (1) Area enclosed by white paint, marked as dots, broken lines, unbroken lines, or white pavers and/or GROUND UNDER REPAIR signage.  
 (2) The practice green on the right of the 18<sup>th</sup> fairway.

**5. BALL DEFLECTED BY POWER LINES**  
 (1) If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hits a power line or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.5 for what to do) UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED, THE PENALTY FOR BREACH OF A LOCAL RULE IS THE GENERAL PENALTY:

Stroke play – Two strokes.  
 Match play – Loss of Hole  
 Plus index +1=15<sup>th</sup>, +2=9<sup>th</sup>, +3=16<sup>th</sup>, +4=13<sup>th</sup>, +5=5<sup>th</sup>.

**6.** The practice putting area and surrounding paths are to be treated as G.U.R.

**7.** Staked trees and staked shrub are no play zones and are ground under repair (the G.U.R. includes the stake and any protective fences).

**8.** The rocks in the red penalty area on holes 8 and 9 are an integral part of the course and as such are immovable obstructions and MUST NOT BE MOVED.

**5. BALL DEFLECTED BY POWER LINES**  
 (1) If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hits a power line or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.5 for what to do) UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED, THE PENALTY FOR BREACH OF A LOCAL RULE IS THE GENERAL PENALTY:

Stroke play – Two strokes.  
 Match play – Loss of Hole  
 Plus index +1=15<sup>th</sup>, +2=9<sup>th</sup>, +3=16<sup>th</sup>, +4=13<sup>th</sup>, +5=5<sup>th</sup>.

**3.** All ornamental garden beds and distance markers.

**4.** Paths both formed concrete, and those dirt tracks caused by the constant wear of continued traffic, and indentations caused by course machinery may be treated as abnormal ground conditions and as such free relief (under Rule 16.1 Relief is nearest point no nearer the hole).

**5.** Exposed tree roots on closely mown areas in the general area and within 3 club lengths of same may be treated as G.U.R.

**6.** The practice putting area and surrounding paths are to be treated as G.U.R.

**7.** Staked trees and staked shrub are no play zones and are ground under repair (the G.U.R. includes the stake and any protective fences).

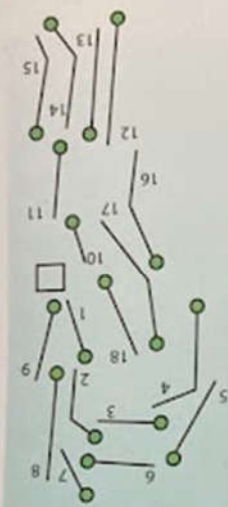

1. OUT OF BOUNDS  
(a) All Boundary Fences.  
(b) Area indicated by white stakes surrounding 9th & 18th holes.  
(c) The area defined by line and white stakes.
2. STAKED TREES  
Any staked tree allows a one club length drop without penalty (no nearer hole) Rule 24.2b
3. HAZARD PEGS  
YELLOW - Water Hazard  
RED - Lateral Water Hazard  
WHITE - Out of Bounds  
WHITE/BLACK TIP - G.U.R  
WHITE/GREEN TOP - Garden
4. BALL PLUGGED & LOST IN FAIRWAY ONLY  
A ball may be dropped in the vicinity of where the ball landed no nearer the hole without penalty. At the discretion of the marker.

5. EMBEDDED BALL  
A ball embedded in the mud may be lifted and dropped without penalty. Under Rule 25.2 (Hazards excluded).
6. A ball lying in a tyre track may be lifted and dropped without penalty.
7. A ball lying or touching or being inconvenienced by stones or pegs may be lifted and dropped no nearer the hole without penalty. (Hazards and Out of Bounds excluded).
8. DRAINS  
All drains not marked by hazard pegs. A ball lying in or within one club length of drain may be dropped behind without penalty. This only applies to the fairway of the hole being played.
9. Grass cutting in the rough may be treated as green keepers rubbish. Relief may be taken under Rule 25.1 (b).
10. Ball striking light posts may be replayed without penalty.

## LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

### 1. Bounds and Margins

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** All grounds outside boundary fences and the lines defined by black and white stakes.

(a) **WATER HAZARDS:** defined by yellow pegs.

(b) **LATERAL WATER HAZARDS:** Defined by red pegs.

(c) **GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** Blue pegs.

### 2. Ground Under Repair

(a) In addition to 1(d) the following may be regarded as G.U.R. and relief taken accordingly:

(i) Tractor or motor vehicle tyre marks and tree roots on fairway sections through the green.

(ii) Embedded rocks on fairways.

(b) If a staked or pegged tree interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing, the player **MUST** take relief as provided in Rule 25-1b(i).

### 3. Temporary Rules

### LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the rules of golf.  
Any additional or temporary local rules are displayed at the club house

**Immovable obstructions**  
The Committee has defined the following to be immovable obstructions for which free relief may be taken under Rule 16.1 : distance markers, hazard stakes, protective hoops, tee banners, tape or rope defining an area, protective screens, all roadways and artificially surfaced paths, the area near the greenkeepers shed and the storage area left of the 12th fairway ( both of these areas defined by an oil line).  
Note: There is no line of play relief from any immovable obstruction.

**Staked trees and garden beds**  
Staked trees and garden beds are no play zones and are ground under repair (the GUR includes any stakes and/or protective guards). Free relief MUST be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1(b)

**Tree roots on fairways**  
Free relief is available under Rule 16.1 if exposed tree roots, only on the closely mown area (areas mown to fairway height or less) if they interfere with the swing or lie of the ball, but no relief is available if interference only affects the player's stance.

**Out of bounds or lost ball**  
The model local rule for the alternative option to stroke and distance is in effect for regular competitions, but not for match play nor certain nominated events. Refer notice board for procedure, or view [www.golf.org.au/18-00b-lustball](http://www.golf.org.au/18-00b-lustball)

**Immovable obstructions close to green eg fixed sprinkler heads**  
Fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1 (a) interference also exists if a ball lies within two club lengths of a sprinkler, which itself is within two club lengths from the green, and that sprinkler intervenes with the line of play. Free relief may be taken under Rule 16.1(b), but there is no relief under this Local Rule if the line of play chosen is clearly unreasonable.

**The penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the General Penalty:**  
Stroke play : 2 strokes, Match play : Loss of hole

## LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf & Temporary Local Rules)

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18-2)

- Those areas beyond the course boundary fences.
- Beyond any line of white stakes with black tops.

### 2. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RULE 16)

- Those areas, the margins of which are defined by white stakes and/or white lines, or by G.U.R. signage.  
NOTE: Stakes defining G.U.R. are Immovable Obstructions.
- Except in a hazard clearly defined wheel marks and/or ruts made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle.

### 3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR - PLAY PROHIBITED

All cultivated garden beds within bounds.

### 4. STAKED TREES & SHRUBS

If a tree or shrub, under 2 clubs in height or staked, interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 16-1a (Immovable Obstruction).  
NOTE: The stakes are Immovable Obstructions.

### 5. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)

- Yellow areas are defined by yellow stakes and/or lines.
- Red areas are defined by red stakes and/or lines.  
NOTE: The stakes are Immovable Obstructions.

### 6. ROADS AND PATHS (16-1)

All roads and paths are Immovable Obstructions.

### 7. POWER LINES, POLES AND STAYS

If a ball strikes an overhead power line, pole or attached stay within the boundary of the course, the ball must be replayed without penalty as near as possible from the spot which the original ball was last played in accordance with Rule 14-5.

## LOCAL RULES

(to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

- OUT OF BOUNDS:** Those areas beyond the course boundary fences.
- PENALTY AREAS:** Yellow penalty areas are defined by yellow stakes and / or lines. Red penalty areas are defined by red stakes and / or lines. When taking relief from the red penalty area on the 3rd/12th hole identified by red stakes with black tops, relief may be taken under Rule 17.1d or, as an extra option, a ball may be dropped in the nearest drop zone.
- DROP ZONES:** The drop zone is defined as the area in any direction that is within 2 club lengths of the drop zone sign. When using a dropping zone, the ball must be dropped in the dropping zone and it MUST come to rest in the dropping zone.
- IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** Taps, water pipes, sprinkler heads, penalty area stakes, drop zone and GUR stakes or signs, tree stakes and guards, Greenkeeper's equipment, tee and distance markers, seats, ball washers, sand and rubbish bins and all course signs including post and ropes.
- POWER LINES:** If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line, pole or support wire, the stroke does not count. The player MUST play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.)
- STAKED TREES:** Staked trees and shrubs, including stake and protective wrapping are no play zones. If a player's ball lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** (a) All areas defined by white stakes and / or lines. (b) Wheel marks made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle, except in a penalty area.
- IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (EG SPRINKLER HEADS) CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS**  
- **LINE OF PLAY INTERFERENCE** Rule 16.1b applies. In addition to interference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is on the player's line of play, and is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. (There is no relief if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

- 4. Trees** - All staked trees or shrubs as defined by white pegs, ball must be lifted and dropped two lengths away but no nearer the hole. (Under Rule 24/2 immovable obstruction.)

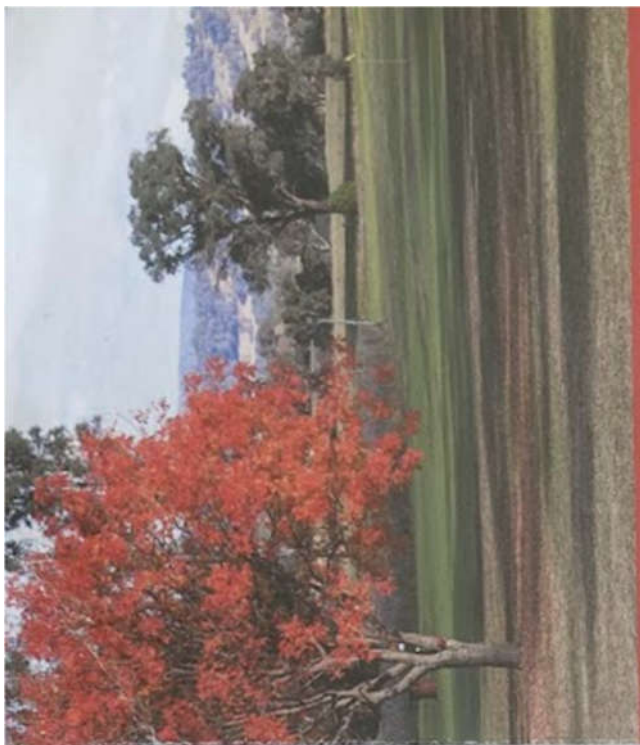

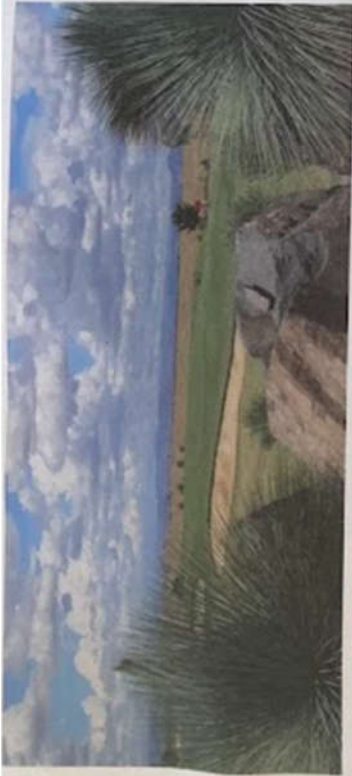

**LOCAL RULES**

**1. Out of Bounds:**  
Those areas beyond the course boundary and those areas beyond any line of white stakes with black tops.

**2. Immovable Obstructions:**  
Distance markers, penalty area pegs, stakes, sprinkler heads, ball washers, rubbish bins, sand bins, tree signs and markers, directional signs, irrigation boxes, sleepers in bunkers, retaining walls including those in bunkers, steps, cart barriers, shade awnings, poles, stags and concrete gully crossings.  
The barrier and its approaches between the 3rd and 4th holes. Relief may be taken in the Drop Zone.

**3. Abnormal Ground Conditions (Ground Under Repair - GUR):**

Areas marked by white stakes and/or lines, sand filled trenches, Any newly laid turf, Clearly defined wheel ruts made by course maintenance machinery, Staked Bunkers, New Earthworks

**4. Integral Objects:**

Large rocks behind the 1st & 2nd greens, on the right of the 4th fairway, between the 4th green & 5th tee and the back of the 4th green, Windmill between the 9th and 10th holes, Wooden Fence on the 11th hole

**5. Additional Rules:**

Relief can be taken if a ball comes to rest in a hole made by a Kangaroo in a bunker. Relief can be taken from embedded stones, if a player's ball hits a power line, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made.
