#### **Golf at Neighbouring Clubs**

Tee times have been reserved at Brora, Golspie and Tain.

Score cards will be prepared for each venue and please return them to the Royal Dornoch rep after conclusion of your round.

The golf format at each venue is to be a stableford competition from the gents card with ladies receiving courtesy shots relevant to the difference in the standard scratch score.

Complimentary soup & sandwiches will be provided at each venue.

Please note that transport to our neighbouring clubs is your own responsibility.

#### **Tours of Distilleries and Places of Interest**

We will supply you with vouchers for entry to the various distilleries and places of interest. These are flexible and can be used on any day between 5<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> September, not necessarily on the day that you have indicated.

Leaflets for all of these are contained in your Welcome Pack and will indicate their opening days/times.

Once again, transport to the venues is your own responsibility and, as a reminder, the alcohol limit for drivers in Scotland is different and more stringent than for the rest of the UK.

#### **Golf at Royal Dornoch**

Both of our courses, Championship and Struie, will be utilised over the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. Due to the amount of guests playing and the time constraints in finishing the round and arriving at the Gala Dinner in good time you may not be allocated the course you preferred. However we have ensured that you will play at least once on both of our courses, if that is what was requested, but you may not get 36 holes on any one course.

#### **Cocktail Party**

Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> September 18:30 – 20:30 (approx.) held in a marquee on the club's practice area. Dress code is casual and golfing attire is very acceptable. There will be transport arranged Page 3 of 4

from Golspie (main car park in centre of town) and Tain (Royal Hotel) departing both towns at 5:30pm to arrive at the marquee in good time for the proceedings. Buses will also ferry guests from Dornoch Square and the Royal Dornoch Clubhouse to the lower links and the marquee. Return transport, at the conclusion of cocktail party, to Tain and Golspie and Dornoch town square is also provided. Should you wish to make your own way then there is ample parking available next to the marquee.

#### **Gala Dinner**

Friday  $9^{th}$  September 18.45 - 23.00 and, like the cocktail party, will be held in a marquee on the club's practice area. Dress code is whatever you would wear to a club function with black tie the fall back option. We ask that you arrive no later than 18:45 as we have arranged for a group photograph of this unique gathering of Royal clubs. We have a single opportunity to do this and this is it, so please don't miss out.

Transport arrangements and timings are the same as for the cocktail party.

The Gala Dinner is the conclusion of the week's events and we hope that you have enjoyed your visit to Dornoch and the celebrations of 400 years of golf.
