

1. All stakes, fixed sprinkler heads, course indicator signs, tee signs, distance markers, GPS stations, light poles and bollards are immovable obstructions.

2. All areas marked Ground Under Repair "Play is Prohibited". Relief from these areas, which are marked with white lines and/or GUR signs, must be taken under Rule 16.1. Where one is available, the drop zone must be used.

1. Wheel ruts made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle may be treated as GUR, except in a Penalty Area.
2. Staked trees and shrubs: if a tree which is staked interferes with a player's stance or intended swing path, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure described in Rule 16.1b.

3. Penalty Areas: Penalty Areas are defined by either:

1. Red stakes and/or lines. The line defines the boundary where both stake and line are evident, or
2. If a ball is within any penalty area that is bounded by a cart path, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 1. Take relief under Rule 17.1 (penalty areas), or
 2. As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball within a two club-length radius from the point on the inside of the cart path directly opposite the point that the ball entered the penalty area. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

4. Out of Bounds is marked by all residential boundary fencing, white stakes with black tops or any construction fences on the course which border land cleared for residential development

1. Internal Out of bounds when playing holes 4, 11, 12 and 17 if your ball crosses the boundary at tunnel entrance (Rule 18.2).

If a ball comes to rest in this area, play is prohibited and the player must take penalty relief under Rule 17.1d (Relief for Ball in Penalty Area) by adding one stroke and playing the next ball from either:

A relief area that is no nearer the hole and within two club lengths of the point at which the ball last crossed the margin of the penalty area, or

A relief area along a reference line extending back from the hole through the point at which the ball last crossed the margin of the penalty area, or

The point at which the previous stroke was played.

6. If a ball lies in the General Area and a sprinkler head on or within two club lengths of the putting green and within two club lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.

7. Any rock, boulder or log that is used to border a cart path is to be treated as part of the path and therefore an immovable obstruction (Rule 16.1).

8. Rocks that have been placed within and along the margins of the Penalty Area on the 2nd hole are an integral part of the course, NO relief is available from these rocks, except under penalty of one stroke as per Rule 19 (Ball Unplayable) if the ball does not lie within the Penalty Area, or Rule 17 (Penalty Areas) if the ball lies within the Penalty Area.

9. If a ball lies in a print, hole or other mark made by a kangaroo (or wallaby) in a bunker, relief may be taken without penalty in accordance with Rule 16.1. Consultation with your marker must be made to determine whether the print, hole or mark is indeed that made by a kangaroo (or wallaby). Failure to consult your marker prior to taking relief may result in a penalty of two strokes (Breach of Local Rule).

LOCAL RULES

Integral Parts of the Course	Includes all posts or stakes defining out of bounds, any fence, gate or artificial object defining out of bounds or any part of an immoveable artificial object that is out of bounds.
Immovable Obstructions	Through the green include all artificially surfaced roads and paths, staked trees, bridges, fixed sprinkler heads and control boxes, stages defining GUR and hazards, wire protection screens, supports and chains, ball washers, rubbish and sand bins, steps, tee markers and distance markers both concrete blocks. Take relief as in Rule 24.2 (i.e. within 1 club length from the NEAREST POINT of RELIEF, no nearer the hole.
Movable Obstructions	Through the green include course seating, hoops defining non walk areas, no cart signs and STONES in BUNKERS. Proceed under Rule 24.1
Ground Under Repair	Compulsory drop. Through the green includes deep wheel ruts make by a tractor or motor vehicle, embedded stones, bare patches on the fairways only, material piled for removal and any hole made by a green keeper whether marked or not. All areas designated by the Committee which are marked in white paint, staked or roped off. Proceed under Rule 25.1 (i.e. within 1 club length from the NEAREST POINT of RELIEF. NOTE: If relief is in a bunker the ball MUST be dropped in the bunker.
Water Hazards	All water hazards are marked with yellow pegs (water hazard) or red pegs (lateral water hazard). Water hazards on the 1st and 3rd holes have yellow pegs on the fairway approach and red pegs on the fairway lateral.
Distance Markers	Black and white posts in the middle of the fairway measure 125 directly to the centre of the green.
Distance Measuring Devices	Distance measuring devices may be used in competition play at Helensvale Golf Club. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance ONLY. If during a stipulated round a player used a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14.3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
Water Hazard - 1st Hole	If there is doubt whether a ball is in or is lost in the water hazard when hitting across the water hazard toward the green, the player may play another ball provisionally under Rule 26-1. If the original ball is found outside the water hazard, the player must continue to play with it. If the original ball is found in the water hazard, the player may either play the original ball as it lies or continue with the ball played provisionally under rule 26-1. If the original ball is not found within the 5 minute search period, the player must continue with the ball played provisionally.

Local Rules

If a staked tree, or Shrub Distance Marker through the green interferes with a player's stroke or intending swing, relief must be taken by dropping without penalty, within one clublength but not nearer the hole. (rule 24-2b)
 All water courses are defined as lateral water hazards and are marked with red stakes (rule 26-1).
 Sprinkler heads, cart paths and cultivated garden beds through the green are immovable obstructions (rule 24-2).
 A ball coming to rest near a kangaroo or wallaby, may be dropped, without penalty, within two club lengths of the nearest point of relief, but not nearer the hole.
 On the 1st and 15th holes only, a provisional ball may be played for a ball that may be in the water hazard. (rule 33-8) Green staff have right of way at all times.
 Smoking Tees 1,3,5,7,9,10,12,14,16,18.
 Please note that smoking is only allowed on these designated tees, no alcohol or food is allowed to be consumed on these tees.

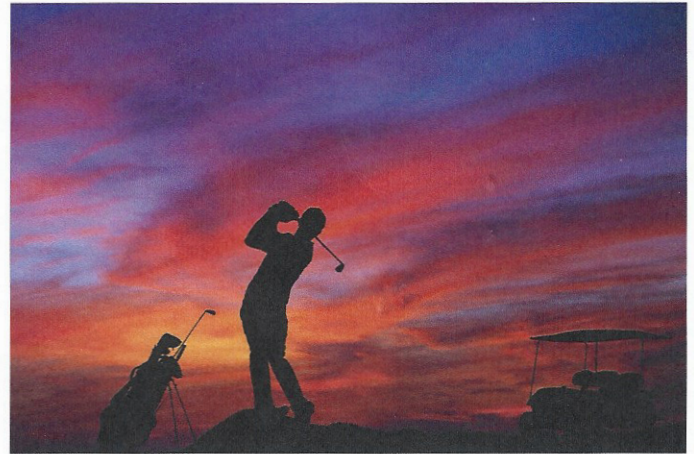

Golf Course Rules

- ◆ Penalty areas are defined by red stakes and/or red lines, and may be treated with lateral relief (*Rule 17.1d applies*)
- ◆ Penalty areas marked with blue lines/stakes indicate a defined drop-zone area is nearby
- ◆ Out of Bounds (OB) is defined by boundary fences and/or white stakes with black tops
- ◆ Traditional "Stroke & Distance" rule applies following any shot hit OB. The next shot **MUST** be played from nearest the original spot of the previous shot – under penalty of one stroke
- ◆ Internal OB - while playing the 4th hole, the 6th hole is "OB" over the water hazard. The boundary line is the right hand side of the hazard that runs the full length of the 4th hole
- ◆ Internal OB - while playing the 6th hole, the 4th hole is "OB" over the water hazard. The boundary line is the right hand side of the hazard that runs the full length of the 6th hole
- ◆ A free drop **MAY** be taken from areas marked GUR (white lines or signs), but **MUST** be taken from GUR areas also marked with white stakes
- ◆ Bare patches on fairways may be treated as GUR
- ◆ Bluestone areas around drains/paths are GUR
- ◆ Exposed tree roots on fairways may be treated with preferred lie (ball placed within one club length no nearer the hole), and in bunkers (ball dropped within one club length, no nearer the hole, within the bunker)
- ◆ All light poles, green electrical housing boxes, distance markers and course signs in general area are immovable obstructions (*Rule 16.1b applies*)
- ◆ In the case of a ball striking a light pole, the shot **MUST** be replayed from nearest its original lie - without penalty
- ◆ Distance markers: 100m, 150m and 200m are measured to the centre of the green.
Pin Positions: red flag - front, white flag - middle, yellow flag - back

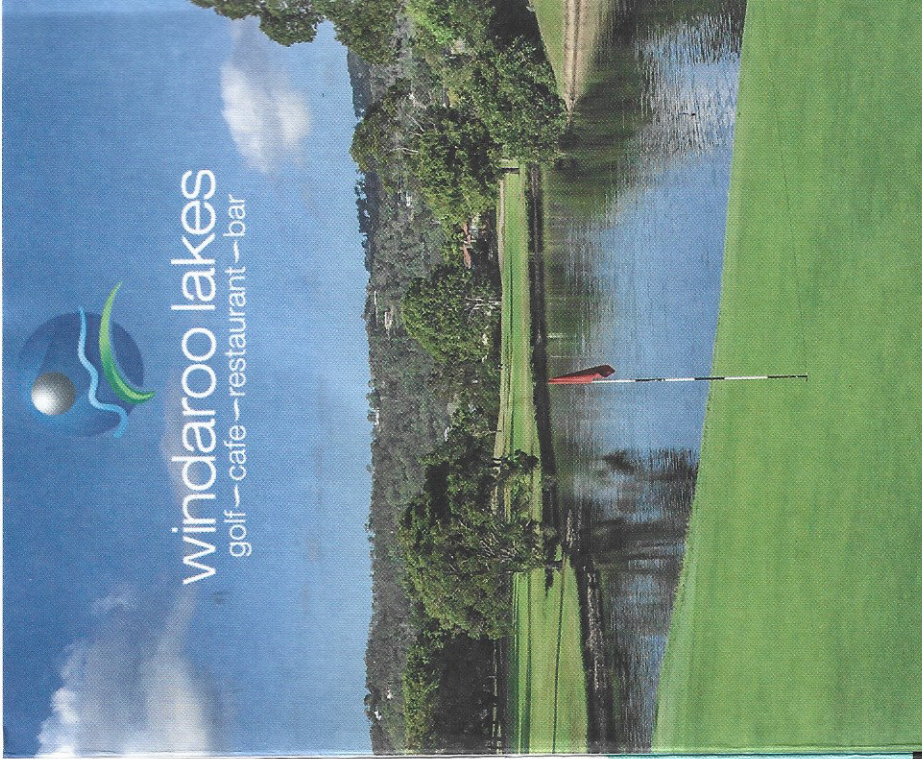

MOTORISED CARTS – CART USE POLICY

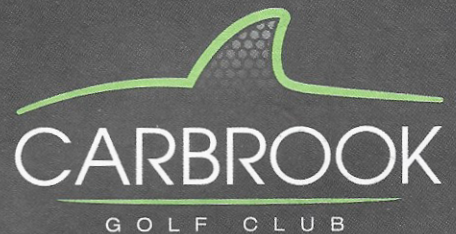
- Must be driven by a licensed driver at all times

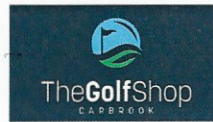

LOCAL RULES (to be read in conjunction with the Local Rules Board & the Rules of Golf)

1. **POWER LINES:** A ball that hits a power line, pylon or power pole must be replayed without penalty
 2. **10th HOLE DROP ZONE:** Drop zone for Penalty Area on the 10th Hole is to the right hand side of the green.
 3. **GENERAL AREA:** Water course which crosses the 1st, 8th, 11th & 18th holes is ruled as General area.
 4. **OUT OF BOUNDS (OOB):** All area beyond the boundary fences of the course or marked by black topped stakes are OOB. When playing the 13th hole the 14th hole is OOB as defined by black top stakes
 5. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** All stakes (except OOB markers), distance markers, hoops, ropes & designated paths are deemed immovable obstructions. Relief is allowed provided the ball is not in a penalty area, 1 club length, no nearer the hole is permitted.
 6. **DESIGNATED PATHS:** Paths consisting of bitumen, concrete and crusher dust and the dirt tracks on the right-hand side of the 18th fairway and on the left-hand side of the 10th fairway (forward of buggy sign) are designated paths.
 7. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR):** All new grounds work is GUR. GUR is marked by white paint or white stakes. Relief - Nearest point of relief plus 1 club length no nearer the hole is permitted.
 8. **NO PLAY ZONES:** Garden beds as defined by orange stakes, tree roots and bare patches on fairways only, clearly visible wheel tracks and ashes. Relief - Nearest point of relief plus 1 club length no nearer the hole is permitted
 9. **STAKED TREES:** Staked trees which interfere with a player's stance or intended swing are immovable obstructions. Relief - Nearest point of relief plus 1 club length no nearer the hole is permitted.
- A. ETIQUETTE**
- (a) Rakes to be placed in the middle of bunkers, facing the line of the fairway.
 - (b) Sand buckets must be carried & used. Please repair all divots and pitch marks.
 - (c) Keep up with the group in front.
 - (d) Walking from the 1st green to the 2nd tee by crossing the 3rd green or fairway is NOT PERMITTED.
 - (e) Walking from the 3rd green to the 4th tee by crossing in front of the 2nd tee block is NOT PERMITTED.
 - (f) Walking from the 16th green to the 17th tee in front of the 5th tee box is NOT PERMITTED.
 - (g) Any golf cart, golf buggy or golf bag is NOT PERMITTED on a putting green
- B. MOTORISED BUGGIES**
- (a) Drive slowly and carefully at all times
 - (b) Keep carts on paths where provided
 - (c) Keep 5 meters from greens
 - (d) Keep 2 meters from all trees and bunkers
 - (e) Avoid driving through wet areas
 - (f) DO NOT leave children unattended on cart
- C. FLAGS**
- Yellow – front
 - White/Green – middle
 - Red – back
- D. STAKES**
- Black Top – OOB
 - Yellow Top – Penalty Areas
 - Red Top – Penalty Areas
 - White – GUR
 - Orange – No Play Zones
 - Blue – Distance markers (to the centre of the green)
- E. YELLOW TEE MARKERS TO BE USED FOR ALL SOCIAL PLAY**
- F. SMOKING:** Is only permitted between tee and green on the following holes; 2, 4, 6, 8, 12, 13, 15 & 17
