

Local Rules & Player Information

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

NOTES & PLAYER INFORMATION:

Buggy Drivers: Please take your sand bucket with you when walking to the ball.

Cart 90 days: Live path until level with ball then drive directly to ball.

Distance Markers: Grass trees or Black Post. Markers are 135 metres to the centre of the green.

Pin Flags: Red - Front, Blue - Centre, Yellow - Rear.

3rd Hole: Buggies are to remain on the path.

2nd and 17th Hole dams: Red Penalty Areas are defined by the edge of the closely mown grass along the rock embankment.

19th Hole wasteland: Red Penalty Area is defined by the edge of the closely mown grass along the edge of the wasteland.

Mobile Phones: Permitted on course but ringtone must be on silent and used in a discretionary manner so as not to disturb other golfers nor interfere with the pace of play.

Wasteland Between the 12th and 14th Holes: This area is 'General Area' and not a Penalty Area. No carts are to be driven in the sand filled area.

Bunkers: Flags are to be placed in the base of the bunkers with the handle facing back along the line of play.

Stakes: Red - Penalty Area.

White with Black Top - Out of Bounds.

White with Green Top - No Play Zone.

LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS: (Rule 2) Those areas beyond the boundary fences. Those areas beyond the line of white stakes with black tops to the right of the 9th fairway, also concrete path marked with black and white lines. Clubhouse and Pro Shop areas defined with black and white lines.

When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bound, the player may proceed under the Stroke and Distance Local Rule for a **penalty of two strokes**, rather than proceeding under stroke and distance. This Local Rule is not available if a provisional ball has been played. See Local Rules Board for full details.

OUT OF BOUNDS 19th FAIRWAY: During the play of the 14th hole, the area to the immediate right of the 14th hole and generally on the fairway side of the cart path on the 15th hole, as defined by white stakes with black tops (OOB stakes), is Out of Bounds. These stakes are treated as Boundary Objects during the play of the 14th hole. For all other holes they are Immovable Obstructions.

STAKED TREES: Where a staked or guarded tree (or Grass Tree Distance Marker) interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 16.1f.

NO PLAY ZONE: (Rule 2.4) Those areas defined by white stakes with green tops and/or white lines and/or No Play Zone sign. Ornamental garden beds as defined by white stakes with green tops and/or No Play Zone sign. All other garden beds are integral parts of the course. Any well-defined machinery or vehicle wheel mark through the green. Erosion marks in bunkers (Rule 16.1c and 16.1f).

DROPPING ZONES: When a player is using a dropping zone, the ball must be dropped in the dropping zone and it must come to rest in the dropping zone.

OVERHEAD WIRES (Including Power Pylons or Poles): Should a player's ball strike any overhead wire/telephone wire and/or pylon/pole, the ball **MUST** be replayed without penalty.

EXPOSED TREE ROOTS: If a player's ball is in the General Area and there is interference from exposed tree roots that are in a part of the General Area cut to fairway height or less (or in the rough within 2 club lengths of the edge of the ground cut to fairway height or less) the tree roots are treated as ground under repair. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (But interference does not exist if the tree roots only interfere with the player's stance.)

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: (Rule 15) All artificial objects on the course that cannot be moved are immovable obstructions, including but not restricted to: **fixed sprinkler heads**, protective netting, cart path bollards and ropes or chains attached, Course indicators, green keeper's white metal hoops and stakes with ropes attached, protective tapes, advertising signs, irrigation control boxes, seats, rubbish bins, ball washers, sand containers/bins, step into bunkers, rocks mounted with course signage, all rock boulder walls and 135 metre distance markers (including grass trees and surrounds). Any buggy path with an artificial surface. Relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

Sprinkler Heads Close to Putting Greens - Line of Play Interference: Rule 16.1b applies to immovable obstructions close to putting greens. In addition, to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play and is within two club-lengths of the putting green and is within two club-lengths of the ball. (Exception - There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

Emergency Siren Procedures: A suspension of play will be signaled by **one prolonged note of the siren**. Players must stop play at once. All other suspensions will be signaled by **three consecutive notes of the siren**, where players may complete the hole that they are playing. In either case, resumption of play will be signaled by **two short notes of the siren**.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE (unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of Local Rule is the general Penalty): Match Play - Loss of Hole; Stroke Play - 2 Stroke Penalty.

Staked Trees:

Are defined by white pegs.

G.U.R:

Marked as white lines or white pegs.
Tyre marks to be treated as G.U.R

Hazards:

Water Hazard = Yellow
Lateral Hazards = Red

Sprinkler Heads:

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstruction and relief from interference by them under Rule 24-2.

Paths and Roadways:

All paths and roadway areas are immovable obstructions. Rule 24-2.

Distance Measuring Devices are permitted.

Distance Markers are measured to the centre of the green.

Check noticeboard for temporary local rules.

Note 1: Etiquette. If competitors fail to keep their place on the course and lose more than one clear hole on the players in front, they must allow the following players to pass.

Note 2: Bunker rakes should be left in flat areas of the bunkers, near access points, pointing in the direction of play.

NON PLAYERS restricted (shoes essential).

- ❖ Permission to enter the course (private property) must be obtained.
- ❖ No non player will walk on the putting greens.
- ❖ Any person hitting a ball on the course must be paid for.

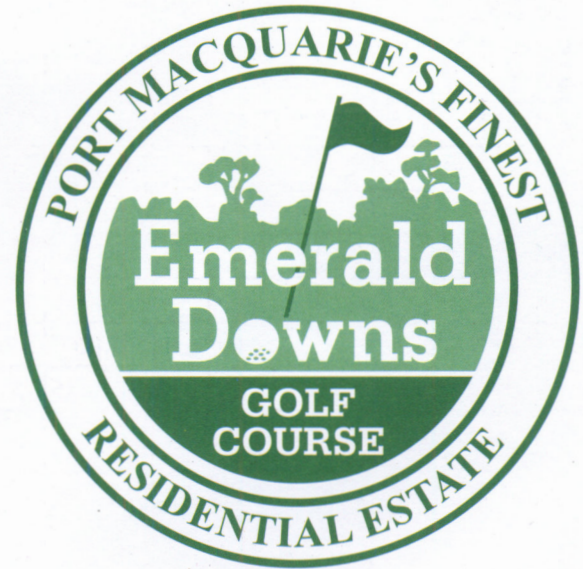

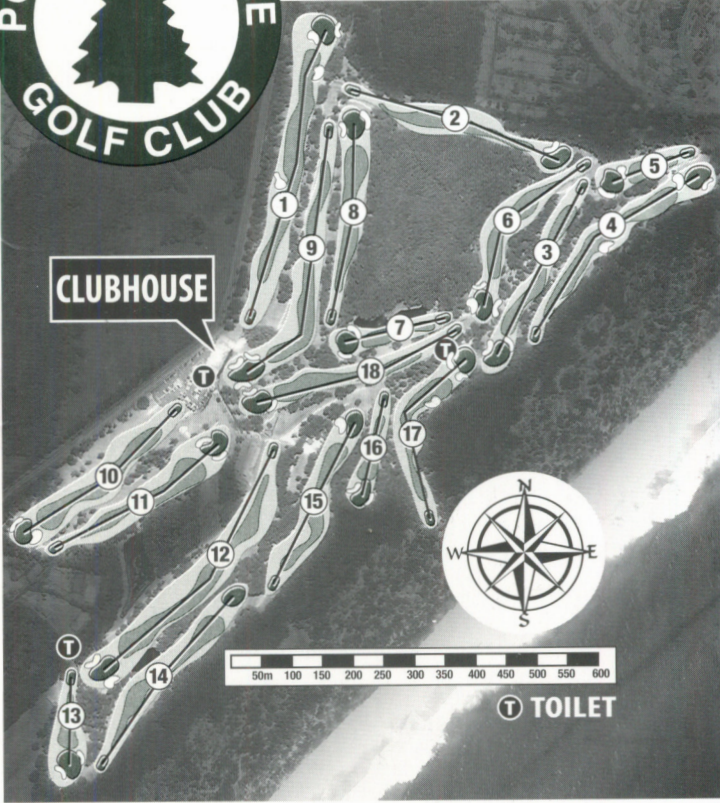

LOCAL RULES - To be read in conjunction with the R&A Rules of Golf

1 OUT OF BOUNDS: The boundaries are the fences to the north, west, south and bordering the car park, the eastern edge of the concrete path and garden adjacent to the putting green and club house and the line of black and white markers adjacent to the first tee and tenth tee and fairway.

2 GROUND UNDER REPAIR:

- a. All rockeries and edged gardens **except** those marked as hazards.
- b. Vehicle wheel tracks.
- c. All white pegged or white ringed areas.

3 IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

- a. All hazard and G.U.R. pegs, distance markers and permanent rope fences and posts.
- b. Fixed Sprinklers, Irrigation fittings, etc

4 ORNAMENTAL TREES: If a staked tree or staked shrub

interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped at the nearest point of total relief but NOT nearer the hole.

5 WATER HAZARDS:

Red stakes - lateral hazard. Yellow stakes - water hazard.

6 EMBEDDED BALL THROUGH THE GREEN:

May be marked, lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point of the marked area but NOT nearer the hole.

7 LIGHTNING: It is a condition of entry to this course that

you acknowledge that you do not rely on us to ensure your safety from lightning. 1 long siren: play discontinued. 2 short sirens: play resumes.

8 FLAG POSITIONS:

Red Flag - Front White Flag - Centre Yellow Flag - Rear

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE: Match Play - Loss of Hole, Stroke Play - Two Strokes.
