LOCAL RULES 11 July 2023

Placing.

If a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in play and playing it from this relief area. The ball SHOULD be marked before lifting and may be cleaned.

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: one club -length.

Limits on Location of Relief Area:

- Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
- Must be in the general area.

Out of Bounds.

Ground beyond the Clubs boundaries defined by fences and ground beyond any line defined by white stakes is out of bounds. A ball is deemed to be out of bounds even if in crossing any adjoining road it comes to rest on any other part of the course.

Abnormal Ground Conditions. (Including Immovable Obstructions)

Players may obtain free relief:

If a ball touches or is in or on abnormal ground conditions.

An abnormal Ground condition interferes with the players area of intended stance or swing. When on a putting green, an abnormal ground condition on or off the green intervenes on the line of play.

The roped off area between holes 9 and 10 during construction of the new hole, including the hazard, is all to be treated as abnormal ground conditions and free relief is allowed.

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: one club -length.

Limits on Location of Relief Area:

- There must be complete relief from all interference by the Abnormal Ground Conditions.
- Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
- Must be in the general area.
