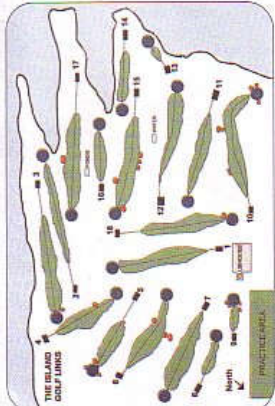

THE ISLAND GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

- OUT OF BOUNDS (rule 27)**
Outside the boundaries of the Course, the ground is not to be played from. Any ball which comes to rest on the ground is out of bounds.
- IN OR OVER CUTTING GRASS (rule 13b)**
In or over cutting grass, the ball is in play. If the ball is in play, the player may play it from where it lies.
- PUTTING GREEN SPRINKLER HEADS**
If a sprinkler head is in the line of play, the player may play the ball from where it lies.
- WATER HAZARDS (rule 26)**

**THE DUKE'S ST ANDREWS
LOCAL RULES**

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27)

Beyond any wall, fence, or line of white stakes or lines bounding the course.

2. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2b)

All artificially surfaced roads and paths including the road and wall at Ice House. The cairn at Well is an immovable obstruction.

3. Movable Obstructions (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

4. Integral Parts of the Course

The wall behind the green at Double Dyke and the rockeries and flower beds at Craigtoun are integral parts of the course. The ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable (Rule 28).

5. Fixed Sprinkler Heads

Specimen Local Rule 5, Appendix 1, Part B applies.

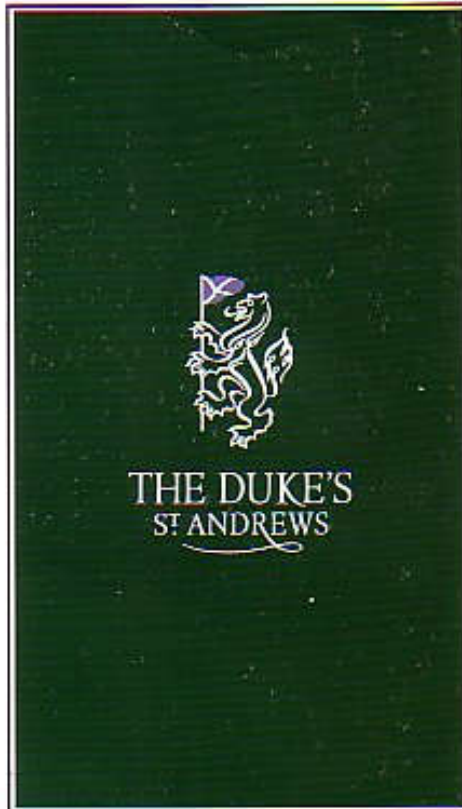

No. 1 COURSE LOCAL RULES

1. **Out Of Bounds (Rule 27)**
A ball is out of bounds if it is lying on or beyond any metallad road, wall or fence bounding the course.
2. **Ground Under Repair (Rule 25-1)**
(a) A player may take relief if he has interference (as defined in Rule 25-1a) from:
(i) Areas marked as G.U.R.
(ii) Outcrops of bare rock.
(iii) Horse hoof marks.
(iv) Aeration Holes.
(b) A player **must** take relief if he has interference from a newly-turfed area enclosed by white lines.
3. **Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)**
(a) All artificial surfaces and artificially surfaced paths and surrounds of paths (including cockleshell surfaces) are immovable obstructions (Rule 24-2b applies).
(b) The specimen Local Rule for immovable obstructions within two club-lengths of putting greens is in effect (see page 129 in the Rules of Golf).
4. **Stones in Bunkers**
Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies).
5. **Bunker Faces**
The face of a bunker that consists of stacked turf is not a "closely-mown area".
6. **Temporary Local Rules**
If any apply, notices will be posted in the Clubhouses and the Starters' Boxes.

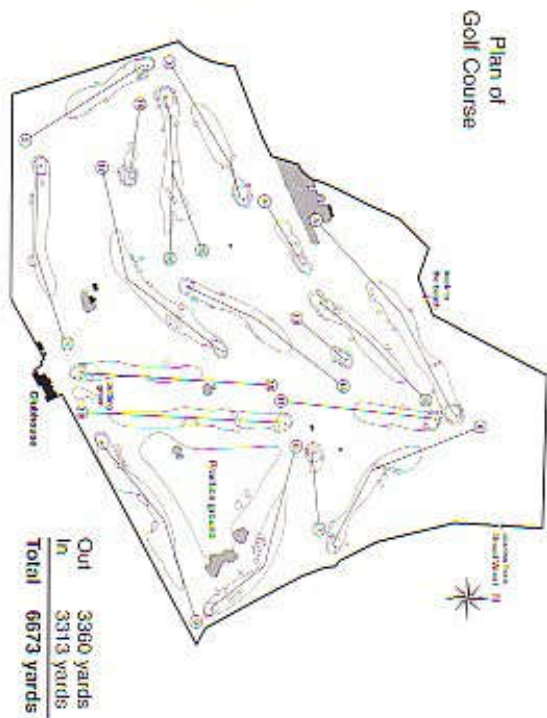

NORTH BERWICK GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

1. CUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)

- a) Beyond a fly wall, fence or white posts bounding the course to the South and to the West.
- b) On or beyond the white line demarcating the short course to the right of the 15th and 16th holes.
- c) Beyond the fence to the right of the 16th hole.
- d) Beyond the fence surrounding the Professional's shop.
- e) Within the clubhouse or the artificially surfaced enclosure surrounding the putting.

2. WATER HAZARDS AND LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

- a) Water hazards marked with yellow stakes are ordinary water hazards.
- b) The beach to the North of the course is a lateral water hazard. The margin of this hazard is either marked by red stakes or is deemed to be where sand, rock or other are continuous.

3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

The fence to the right of the 1st hole is an immovable obstruction. The maintenance road and multi-paved path that runs from the 10th green to the 15th teebox are immovable obstructions. Relief can be obtained under Rule 24-2.

4. PRACTICE PUTTING GREEN (Rule 25-3)

- a) The practice putting greens are wrong greens.
- b) For the purpose of Rule 25-3, the putting green of the 4th hole includes the apron surrounding the green when playing the 14th hole.

5. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE (Rule 20)

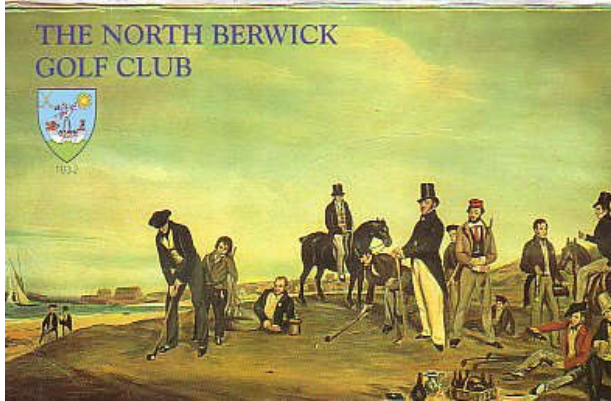
All artificial paths and stone walls are integral parts of the course as are the paths that cross the 1st and 16th holes as is the path to the right of and crossing the 17th hole. The ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable.

6. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a ball lies on the putting green but not in a hazard and such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green and within two club lengths of the ball (whichever is the furthest) between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which is not nearer the hole, is outside such interference and is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be played as it lies.

7. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

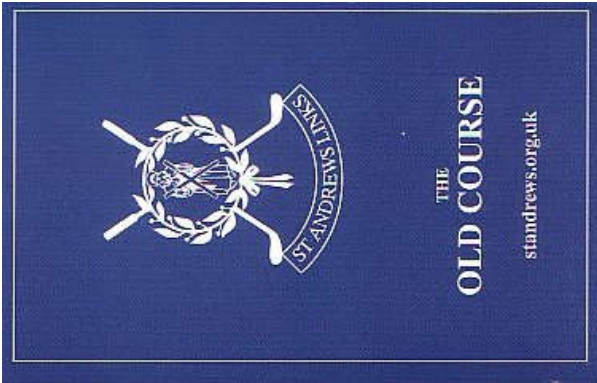

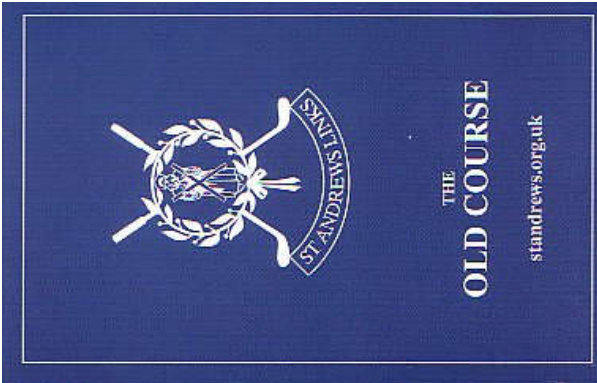

- b) The pond at left of 6th Hole.
- c) Blue Nine – The drain on the left of the 13th Hole.
- d) Yellow Nine – The drain on the left of the 2nd Hole. The pond on the left of the 7th Hole.

4. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS – Rule 24-2

- a) Sprinkler Heads, Manhole Covers
- b) Seats, Shelters, Sheds, Scaopers, Artificial Paths/Roads other than approach to Club (see local Rule 1).

Note: If a fixed sprinkler head on or within 2 club-lengths of the green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play, relief may be obtained, without penalty, as follows:

If the ball lies off the green but not in a hazard and is within 2 club-lengths of the sprinkler head, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at nearest point to where it lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not a hazard or on putting green.

5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR – Rule 25

Areas marked by white lines.

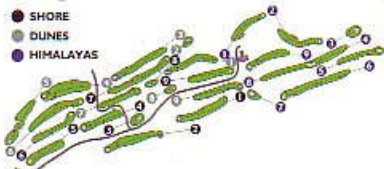

LOCAL RULES

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)**
 (a) Over all boundary fences including the seashore at the 1st and 2nd holes on the SHORE course. Otherwise the seashore is not out of bounds.
 (b) Both the old and new clubhouse and on or over all surrounding footpaths and car parks.
- 2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**
 All water hazards are marked with yellow stakes.
LATERAL WATER HAZARDS
 All lateral water hazards are marked with red stakes.
- 3. BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)**
 Stakes in bunkers are movable obstructions. A ball plugged in a reverted face of a bunker is defined as not being in a hazard and must be declared unplayable in accordance with Rule 28.
- 4. WRONG PUTTING GREENS (Rule 25-3)**
 Should your ball land on the wrong green or apron, you must lift and drop your ball not less than 2 club lengths outside the apron of the green and not nearer the hole. In addition both the putting greens alongside the old and new clubhouses are 'wrong' greens.
- 5. ROADS (Rule 24-2)**
 All roads shown on the map of the course on this card are immovable obstructions, the ball shall be dropped within one clublength of the edge of the obstruction nearest to where the ball lay, but not nearer the hole. All other tracks are an integral part of the course and there is no relief.
- 6. POP-UP SPRINKLERS (Rule 24-2)**
 All pop-up sprinklers are immovable obstructions and relief from them may be obtained under Rule 24-2.

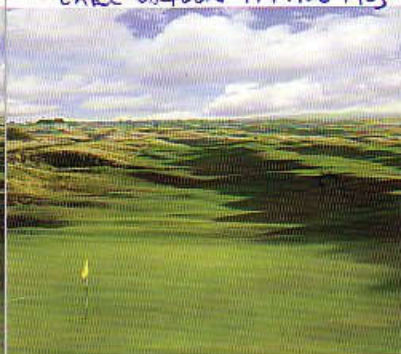

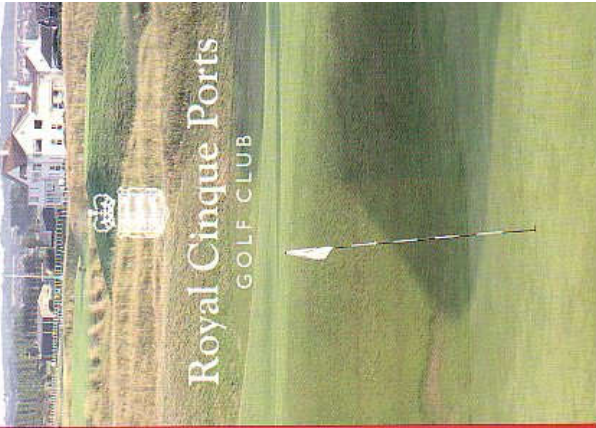

- ANCIENT HIGHWAY** where it crosses the 11th hole and to the left of the 12th fairway (indicated by white stones) are areas of G.L.U.R. (Rule 25-1a and 1b).
- STONES IN BUNKERS** are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies).
- FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS** - all fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction is on or within two club lengths of the hole being played, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows: If the ball lies on the putting green but not in a hazard, and is within two club lengths of the interfering obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which a) is not nearer the hole, and b) avoids such interference, and c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- RED PATHWAYS** are an integral part of the course and as such do not qualify for relief.

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

- Beyond the fences marking the boundary of the course. (The boundary fence is the innermost fence either side of the right of way on the 8th hole).
- Over the white line in front of the practice putting green.
- Inside the fence surrounding the pond to the left of the 6th green.

2. WATER HAZARDS

All ditches on the course are water hazards. (Lateral Water Hazards are indicated by red posts).

3. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE

- The Club House.
- The Flag Pole and Flags.
- The road crossing the course from the gate by the 12th green to the railway line.
- The road alongside the railway line from the 1st to the 8th holes.

4. OBSTRUCTIONS

The fences alongside the public footpath across the 8th hole and between the 10th and 11th holes are NOT boundary fences. Along with the path itself they are defined as 'Removable Obstructions' from which relief may be obtained in accordance with Rule 24-21. The sprinkler heads and hydrant boxes of the watering system are 'Removable Obstructions' from which relief may be obtained in accordance with Rule 24-21. In addition, if such an obstruction, or or within two (2) lengths of the putting green of the hole being played, intervenes between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty, as follows:

- If the ball lies on the putting green, it may be lifted, cleaned and placed not nearer the hole at the nearest point at which intervention by the obstruction is avoided.
- If the ball lies off the putting green (but not in a bunker) and is within one club length of the intervening obstruction it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point at which intervention by the obstruction is avoided.

5. BUNKERS

- Stones in bunkers are deemed to be 'removable obstructions'.
- The face of a bunker which consists of stacked turf, and may be grass-covered or earthen, is neither part of the bunker nor a 'closely mown area' (Rule 25-2).

 2. **WATER HAZARDS**
Are defined by yellow flags.
 3. **LATERAL WATER HAZARDS**
Are defined by red flags.
 4. **INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE**
Are defined by the course map. The course is a regional park of the course.
 5. Grass fences in bushes are not deemed to be closely mown areas.
 6. There are no grass keepers acting as gatekeepers.
 7. All ground under repair is marked with a red flag or indicated by a white line.
 8. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS**
Stolens, tree stumps, concrete, masonry, masts, telegraph poles and 150V poles.
 9. **FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS**
Fixed sprinkler heads or hydraulic boxes are immovable obstructions unless they are from maintenance by them may be obtained under Rule 24.2.
- In addition, if such an obstruction or a white line club-length or of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows:
- (a) If the obstruction or white line intervenes between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, if the ball is on the line of play and the player is not in a hazard and the ball is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
 - (b) If the obstruction or white line intervenes and the ball is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

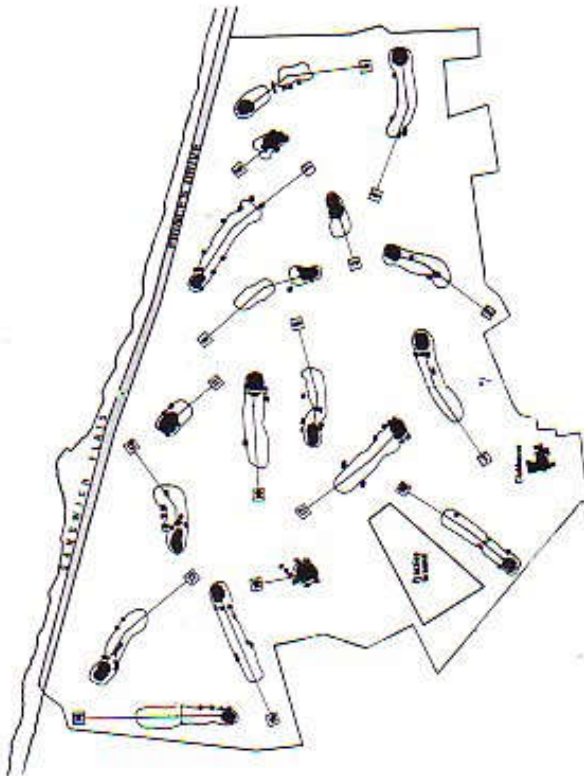

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. (Rule 24-1 applied)

Fixed Sprinkler Heads
All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24.2. In addition, if such an obstruction is or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played incursions on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows:
If the ball lies on the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:
Moron play - Loss of hole; Stroke play - Two strokes.
Road behind 18th Green
This road is an integral part of the course and no relief is allowable under Rule 24-2b(i).
Water Hazards (Rule 26-1).
The ditch crossing the 14th hole known as the Sunz Canal is a water hazard.
The ditch to the right of the 1st hole and adjacent to the boundary fence is a lateral water hazard.
Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1).
Beyond all boundary stakes and fences around the course is out of bounds.
