














The Metropolitan Golf Club is delighted to welcome our friends from across the Tasman and around Australia to the 2017 Bledisloe Cup Challenge.

Conditions of Play Friday 18th August 2017

Bledisloe Challenge Trophy

- Each player will play Single Stableford off handicap advised.
- Play will be from the White Tees (Club Course).
- A handicap limit of 36 will be permitted.
- The Team score to decide the winner will be the cumulative total of the best five (5) individual Stableford scores of each team.
- The Barbarians team is ineligible to win the Bledisloe Challenge Trophy.

Method of deciding ties

- If a team aggregate score is tied with another team then the 6th best card of each team will be added to decide the count back and establish a result.
- If there is still a tie then the cumulative total of the original five cards back nine scores will be used to decide the winner.

Geoffrey (Fusion) Hartigan Trophy

- The player returning the card with the lowest Stableford score shall be the winner.
- The usual method of count back will apply to decide a tie.
- Members from the Barbarians team are ineligible to win the Geoffrey (Fusion) Hartigan Trophy.

Graham Langridge Jug

- The player returning the card with the highest Stableford score shall be the winner.
- The usual method of count back will apply to decide a tie.
- Members from the Barbarians team are ineligible to win the Graham Langridge Trophy.

Trans-Tasman Trophy

- The Team score to decide the winner will be the cumulative total of the fifteen (15) best individual cards from each country.
- Should this result in a tie then the next best card of each country will be added to the total until a result is established.
- Scores from members of the Barbarians team will not count towards the Trans-Tasman Trophy.

Bledisloe Golf: How it started

In 1997, Wellington GC, as it was then, had arranged to play Royal Sydney GC at the Metropolitan GC on Friday 25 July, before attending the first Bledisloe Rugby Test ever to be played at the MCG on Saturday 26 July. The Australian GC and Metropolitan GC were also playing a match so it was decided to have a tournament involving all 4 teams plus a Barbarians team, selected by the host club.

The format of the tournament was Teams of 8 playing a stableford competition off handicap, from the Championship tees, with the best 5 scores from each team counting towards the overall team score. The team with the highest score won the Bledisloe Golf Trophy.

Graeme Hastings of Metropolitan GC donated the trophy, a glass rugby ball mounted on a wooden base, with support from Max Farr-Jones, and others at Metropolitan GC. The first winners were Wellington GC. The Barbarian team included former Wallabies Andrew Slack, Bill Ross and Greg Cornelsen. Thus, started the Bledisloe Golf Trophy.
